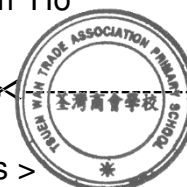

School report for December

1. Teachers' professional development

- a. To arouse teachers' professional development, our General Studies Department joined different collaboration projects. On 5 December, teacher from Primary 2 had peer lesson preparations with teachers from other schools. On 6 December, teacher from Primary 6 joined the activity of STEM teaching project.
- b. On 6 December, representatives of the Education Bureau from Yu Nan, Guangdong visited our school. They had better understanding about the small class teaching situation in HK schools.

2. Students' all-round development

- a. On 1 December, P6 students visited a secondary school to know more about the school life in this stage. It enabled them to have better understanding about choosing secondary school places.
- b. From 16 December to 21 January, our school has organized a roving art gallery in different Estates and commercial complexes in Tsing Yi District.
- c. On 17 and 23 December, the prefects and the cub scouts of our school were responsible for booths in Tsing Yi Estate and Kwai Tsing District Fire Prevention Carnival respectively. The spirit of serving others of prefects and cub scouts was uplifted.
- d. Students enjoyed the Christmas activities held during 18-21 December. The speaking and listening fluency of our students as well as their knowledge of foreign festivals were enhanced.
- e. We have our school's Christmas celebration party every year. The school arranged some talent performances for that day, showcasing the talents of our students. The performances were diverse, including singing, dancing and playing of musical instruments. In fact, from 15 December till 18 December, the activity team arranged different levels of students to perform so that the more distinctive ones could be chosen for the Christmas celebration party.

3. Parent-school cooperation

- a. On 8 December, our school organised a talk for parents regarding P6 students to be promoted to Secondary 1 in the next school year. The talk enhanced parents' understanding of the S. 1 Discretionary places application system and methods. Also appearing in the talk was Principal of Wai Kiu College, who introduced secondary school life to our students and parents.
- b. On 9 December, our school arranged an Open Day to allow kindergarten parents to visit our facilities and learn about the paths of our school leading to more quality teaching and learning.
