School report for May

1. Teachers' professional development

- a. On 5 May, our principal together with 5 General Studies teachers including Mr. S.L. Lee, Mr. Y.W. Yiu, Ms. W.Y. Lam, Ms. C.K. Wong and Ms. H.Y. Sum attended a seminar about how science and technology influence the society.
- b. On 11 May, our principal and Mr. S.L. Lee shared the experience gained from our school about STEM education with the principals from Shenzhen.

2. Students' all-round development

- a. On 2 May, a Dunhuang school paid a visit to us; the number of participants was more than 40, including their teachers, students and parents. On that day, pupils of the Dunhuang school had dancing performance with our pupils. Cultural awareness was raised.
- b. On 9, 12, 16 May, P3 pupils attended swimming lessons. Our school's physical education curriculum incorporates the swimming element into the six major areas of study. We provide opportunities for students to learn the swimming skills and arouse students' interest in swimming. The body strength of our students could be uplifted. The school also provides 3 sessions of swimming lessons to P4 students in the first term.
- c. On 27 May, our school held a carnival named <STEM UP @ TWTAPS Carnival>. Many students came back to school to participate the activities. Parents appreciated the effort we paid in STEM education.
