## Recent school report

### 1. Teachers' professional development:

- a. From 7 to 14 July, Ms Lam Wai Yan acted as the P3 TSA marker.
- b. From 16 July to 3 August, Ms Sum Hiu Yeung and Ms Lam Wai Yan participated in the Putonghua teaching training advanced course.
- c. On 27 August, all teachers attended a workshop about positive education conducted by our education therapist.
- d. On 28 August, an English expert, Dr Tang led a workshop titled "Workshop on Phonics Teaching". All our English teachers attended to discuss a related school-based support programme about phonics for the new school year and the expert provided precious opinion on the development of our English subject.

### 2. Students' all-round development

- a. On 3 July, all P6 students attended the Teacher Appreciation Lunch gathering to express their thanks to all the teachers.
- b. On 10 July, secondary places allocation results were released, with all our P6 students being able to get into their target secondary schools. 90% of our students were allocated to one of their first three choices. This figure is higher than the territory average. About one third of the students entered EMI secondary schools. All our teachers and students felt proud of it.
- c. On 11 July, students participated in a summer activity. P1-3 students visited Hong Kong Wetland Park. Their knowledge and understanding of the inherent values of wetlands were uplifted. P4-6 students visited Ngong Ping to have 360 Buddhist Walk. Some other P4-6 students visited Science Park in Tsim Sha Tsui to have science exploration.
- d. On 12 July, P1-3 students visited sky100 Hong Kong Observation Deck. They admired the beautiful scenery of Hong Kong.
- e. On 13 July, our students paid a visit to Madame Tussauds. They could take photos with the famous wax figures.
