## School report for October

### 1. Teachers' professional development

- a. On 2 and 16 October, our consultant, Dr. Tang Mei Sin had implemented class observation. After the lessons, she had a co-planning meeting with our P1 and P2 teachers, and gave precious opinions to improve the teaching effectiveness for the forthcoming lessons.
- b. All teachers from various paid a visit to Huizhou Schools for teaching exposure and exchange on 19 and 20 October. Teachers toured the laboratories and teaching facilities in the primary and secondary schools of Huizhou with positive comments and appreciation. In addition, Mr. Chan Ho Cheung and Ms. Sham Winnie held a co-teaching reading lesson for one of the local P.5 classes. Teachers from different schools of Hong Kong not only had fruitful discussions with the teachers from Huizhou, but they also shared their insightful ideas on teaching practices after the teaching sessions.

### 2. Students' all-round development

- a. On 15 October, the school held the first fire drill of the year to educate students the importance of fire safety. Through the activity, teachers and students can learn better about the route for escape. Furthermore, the training can enable students to deal with contingency, raising their safety awareness in the long run.
- b. Students enjoyed the Halloween activities held during 25-31 October. The speaking and listening fluency of our students as well as their cultural knowledge of foreign festivals were enhanced.

### 3. Parent-school cooperation

- a. On 6 October, a talk for P1 parents on how to enhance children's self-management ability was organized. Parents found the talk very informative and practical in dealing with the psychological changes of their children with the new school environment.
- b. The first Incorporated Management Committee meeting of the year was conducted on 9 October. Supervisor, Sponsoring Body Manager and Parent Manager expressed precious opinions on the development of the school. Considerable discussions were made to facilitate better school operations.
- c. On 14 October, a number of students and parents participated the activity "Inclusion" which was organized by Hong Kong Federation of Handicapped Youth. Through the activity, the participants can feel and experience the difficulties and limitations that the handicapped face with a hope to nurture the spirit of equality and respect.
- d. From 22 to 26 October, teachers and parents monitored whether all lunch sets provided by the lunch supplier are in compliance with the requirements of Nutritional Guidelines on Lunch for Students in five consecutive school days.
- e. On 28 October, more than 70 teachers, students and parents participated the Yan Chai Charity Walk. A total amount of \$14,436 dollars was donated by the teachers and students of the school.
- f. Parent Manager and Alternate Parent Manager were successfully elected after the poll. Mr. Chan Wai Ho, the father of Chan Yu Yeung in class 2A is elected as the Parent Manager while Ms. Pam Wan, the father of Mo Kam Hin in class 4A is elected as the Alternate Parent Manager.
