School report for January

1. Teachers' professional development

- c. From 14 to 18 January, Mr. C.H. Cheng attended the Basic Course on Catering for Diverse Learning Needs.
- d. On 22 January, Mr. C.Y. Chong and Ms. Y.T. Cheung attended the participated in the workshop on Building a Harmonious and Anti-bullying School Environment for professional development.

2. Students' all-round development

- a. On 16 January, P1 to P4 students participated in our school's Mathematics Day and learnt by completing the maths games or speed calculation with great fun.
- b. On 18 January, students were arranged to participate in the Jump Rope for Heart and style skipping demonstration activities held by the PE team. Students obtained a lot of information on the benefits for doing skipping exercise.
