School report for February

- 1. Teachers' professional development
- a. From 7 January to 1 February, Mr. H. Zhong attended a 4-week Thematic Course on Catering for Diverse Learning Needs for SEN Students.
- b. From 11 February to 15 February, Mr. C.Y. Chong and Ms H.Y. Sum attended a 5-day Foundation Course on Catering for Diverse Learning Needs for Students.

2. Students' all-round development

- a. In order to develop interests and talents, students were able to participate in various types of activities, including Fencing, Unicycle, Rugby and playing musical instruments such as Saxophone and Cello in the 2nd term. Students will obtain a lot of experience for personal growth.
- b. In order to let the capable students learn more, Chinese enhancement programmes were introduced in the second term to develop the talents of our students.
