School report for April

1. Teachers' professional development

- a. From 8 April to 12 April, Ms. C. W. Tam took an In-depth Course on Mental Health Promotion at Schools and Supporting Students with Mental Health Needs for the 2018/19 School Year (PRIMARY) for five days.
- b. From 9 April to 13 April, teachers of the school, Ms. M.Y. Huang and Ms. Y.T. Li joined the Committee on Professional Development of Teachers and met the representatives of the Education Bureau from Anhui, Hebei City. They had better understanding about the education, economy, society and culture of mainland, thus enriching their teaching profession in the areas of implementation and leadership in teaching and learning .

2. Students' all-round development

- a. To enable students to broaden their horizons, broaden their horizons, and get a wide-life learning opportunity, our school intends to hold a historical exploration tour to Dunhuang and Xian, China from 13 to 19 April 2019. Our teachers with our students visited our Sister School in Dunhuang by plane and toured Terracotta Army, Zhonglou Square, Muslim's Quarter, Mogao Caves and Crescent Spring for extensive learning and exploration. Students were exposed to a ranged of cultural sightseeing spots for learning and reflection. All students had enriched their understanding about the history, conservation, and art and culture of the mainland.
- b. On 23 April, students were encouraged to read through a series of multisensory reading activities at school on World Book Day. The activities included Interactive Reading Fair, Story Times, AR Joyful Reading, Inspirational Book Theatre Workshop, "Geronimo Stilton" Story Telling, Kung Fu Poem and Interactive Hand-Painted Story Theatre. The enjoyable activities inspired the students to read across the curriculum in many different fun ways.

3. Parent-school cooperation

- a. On 3 April, there was a food tasting activity in preparation for the next year's lunch food provider. A few suppliers participated, with 19 parents and 8 students as well as some teachers assessing the service, hygienic conditions, prices and tastiness of each supplier and giving precious comments to the selection committee.
- b. On 26 April, it was the Parents Day. Parents communicated with the teachers and got the student's report from school. There was an exhibition and speech therapy talk on the same day. Parents and students toured the hall and showed great interest and admiration about the excellent work done by our students. After the tour, they attended the book fair and bought story books for home reading. Some parents even bought educational CD-ROMs for their children for further learning.
