School report for May

- 1. Teachers' professional development
- a. From 2 May to 13 May, Ms. C. W. Tam took the Thematic Course on Supporting Students with SEN Cognition and Learning Needs.
- b. On 10 May, Mr. S.L. Lee and Mr. C.C. Mong paid a visit to Futian Qiaoxiang Foreign Language School in Futian province in Shenzhen to attend a demonstration on Intelligent Classroom System. With the technology 5G Networking system, the event gave an in-depth demonstration on the use of the intelligent system in real time for classroom teaching settings. Artificial Intelligence was also used to facilitate teaching and monitoring of multiple classrooms for teachers with ease.

2. Students' all-round development

- a. On 15 May, one of our sister schools from Dunhuang paid a visit to us; the number of participants was more than 40, including their teachers, students and parents. On that day, pupils of the Dunhuang school had dance performances with our pupils. Cultural awareness was raised.
- b. In order to enable students to obtain a broad and balanced learning experience, the school-based physical education curriculum covers eight major areas of study. We hold swimming lessons every year for P.3 & P.4 students to develop students' interest in swimming. From April to May, P3 pupils attended swimming lessons. There were professional pool lifeguards and award swimming instructors to guide students to carry out the activities. With the implementation of swimming classes, swimming skills and students' interest in swimming could be enhanced.
- c. On 27 May, our school held a carnival named <STEM UP @ TWTAPS Carnival>. Students from different kindergartens and primary schools with our students participated the event and enjoyed the interactive scientific activities with great fun. Parents found the activities engaging and appreciated the efforts we paid in STEM education.

3. Parent-school cooperation

- a. On 18 May, our school joined the Flag Day, which was organised by the Yan Chai Hospital for charity fund-raising purposes. Through the event, it could help enhance students' awareness of society and broaden students' learning experience. It also provided an opportunity for students to meet different people in the community with their parents.
- b. On 15 and 24 May, our school invited Ms. S.P. Wong, Senior Lecturer from Education University of Hong Kong, and Ms. F.T. Fuk, a Certified Lecturer to conduct two Parental Talks on Pursue of Happiness and Building Good Personality. Parents found the content very useful for them.
- c. Till last school year, the school will make collection from students for specific purposes based on the guidance given by Education Bureau to compensate part of the spending on overall learning activities such as the electricity charges for air-conditioning the campus every year. The balance of the collection of fees and charges for specific purposes last year is \$30174.14, please visit our school website for further information.
