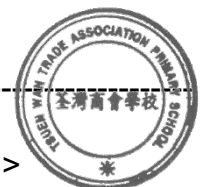

School report for June

1. Teachers' professional development

- b. On 22 June, Ms K.F. KO was awarded the most outstanding teacher award from the Joint Schools' Parent and Teacher Association for Kwai Tsing in the 2018/19 school year.
- c. On 25 June, Mr K.H. Chow and Ms M. P. LEONG has served in the Community Youth Charity (CYC) team for many years. They got the Devoted Service Award. She actively promotes the activities from the CYC to the students from our school. She was, therefore, presented a certificate in recognition of her hard work.
- d. In the 24th Parents-Also-Appreciate-Teacher Drive, the awardees, senior teachers, Mr. K.O. WONG and Mr. C. H. CHENG had been chosen after the poll collected from teachers and parents. They would take part in the prize-giving ceremony on 10 September.

2. Students' all-round development

- a. On 31 May, it's our school's Graduation Ceremony. Mrs. Kwok Wong Mun Yi, Senior School Development Officer (Kwai Tsing), officiated the ceremony. Many guests, parents and students attended the ceremony on that day. Various academic prizes and graduation certificates were awarded to our graduates. Besides, the performances of our students were given to our visitors with great applause.
- b. On 6 June, the school organised "The Green Day" to value the promises we had made to keep the environment. All students were asked to wear batches and green school uniforms. In addition, P1 and P2 students were also invited to attend a talk given by World Green Organisation on climatic change and renewable energy.
- c. From 12 to 13 June, the school organised the "Putonghua Fun Day". A number of interactive and interesting activities were held at booths so as to encourage students to experience Putonghua with fun. All students were delighted to speak and use Putonghua as a tool to communicate with teachers and classmates.
- d. On 13 June, our students paid a visit to the Education Path at the Electrical and Mechanical Services Department (EMSD) Headquarters at Kowloon Bay to deepen the awareness of green building technologies and stress the importance of renewable energy and energy saving. The solar panels were also demonstrated in the building.
- e. On 14 and 17 June, students of P5 and P6 went to Avenue of Stars in Tsim Sha Tsui and Maritime Square in Tsing Yi as outreach activities to broaden their horizons. All students formed into groups and interviewed the tourists and residents by using Ipads and questionnaires.
