Circular on Beijing Study Tour

Our school participated in the 'Values Education ("Basic Law" and Chinese Culture) Student Short Film Creation Competition' held by the Education Bureau (EDB). Travel documents	Participants should hold Mainland Travel Permit for Hong Kong and Macau Residents / Passport and China tourist visa, or other valid travel document which is valid for at least 6 months before the trip

The details are as follows: Date: 5th August, 2019 (Monday) Time: 10:00-10:45 a.m. Venue: Room W301, West Block, EDB Kowloon Tong Education Services Centre, 19 Suffolk Road, Kowloon Tong ● To promote the experience of the study tour, students will be filmed, recorded or videotaped during the tour. All copies, reprints or displays of the portraits and sounds of the students involved will be used for educational and promotional purposes. If parents do not agree, please inform the EDB at the latest two working days before departure, in written form with signature to Miss WONG Ching-lai (Room 402, 4/F, Kowloon Government Offices, 405 Nathan Rd, Yau Ma Tei, Hong Kong). If the EDB does not receive a written notice on the deadline, it will assume parents agree with the arrangement.

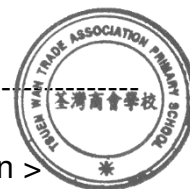
