Recent school report

- 1. Teachers' professional development:
- a. In mid-July, Miss Lam Wai Yan and Miss So Kik Yee acted as the P3 Chinese TSA marker and P6 Mathematics TSA marker respectively.
- b. On 10 July, our school invited Principal Chu Kwok Keung from Ta Ku Ling Ling Yink Public School to hold a teachers' workshop for the cultivation of positive culture in school.
- c. On 15 July, four teachers from our school had a field trip to Chu Hai.
- d. On 29 August, our school invited 'Positive Discipline' school speaker Miss Lilian Chan to hold a positive education teachers' workshop for all our teachers.
- e. On 30 August, all our teachers and other staff attended a workshop on the protection of our spines.

2. Students' all-round development

- a. On 11 July, our school joined a wall design and painting activity held by the Incorporated Owners of Tsing Yi Estate.
