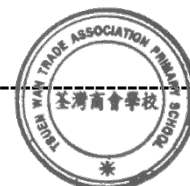

School report of October

1. Teachers' professional development

- a. From September to June, P.3 Chinese teachers conduct school-based support plan (Chinese) co-planning meeting every alternate Thursday, studying teaching methods and activities.
- b. From 14 October to 17 October, Ms. C. W. Tam attended a Professional Development Programme for the Special Educational Needs Coordinators (SENCO) (2019/21) for four days.
- c. From 18 October to 17 November, P.3 Mathematics teachers conduct Chinese University of Hong Kong small class teaching and learning support (Mathematics) meeting, discussing teaching and learning strategies.

2. Students' all-round development

- a. P.4 swimming lessons start in September and October. The physical education curriculum of our school covers eight major areas of study, and swimming is one of them. Every year our school adds the learning of swimming to the physical education curriculum, so as to cultivate students' interest in swimming.
- b. Starting from 29 October, our English team holds a series of Halloween activities. Apart from knowing about western cultures and festivals/ activities, students also learn different English vocabulary and communicate with English. On 31 October students wear different types of Halloween costumes and participate in activities. Their interest in learning English, and their English listening and speaking abilities have been enhanced.

3. Parent-school cooperation

- a. From 23 September to 27 September, parents came to school and supervised the quality of the meal boxes provided by the lunch supplier.
- b. To support environmental protection and to make good use of technology for the convenience of parents, our school will try to use electronic notice. Before fully implementing such use, our school will assess the usage condition of our parents. For parents, please follow the instructions provided to install the GRWTH mobile phone app first. Our school website also provides video teaching parents how to install the GRWTH app.
- c. On 13 October, over a hundred students and parents joined the activity "Joint Charity Walk" held by Hong Kong Federation of Handicapped Youth, encouraging students to feel for and experience the difficulties and limitations of the physically disabled people and nurturing their respect of others.
- d. On 20 October, over 60 teachers, students and parents participated in the "Yan Chai Charity Walk" activity. Teachers and students from our school have raised \$11,330.
- e. The first Incorporated Management Committee meeting of the year was conducted on 26 October. Supervisor, Sponsoring Body Manager and Parent Manager expressed precious opinions on school policies, and gave guidance on the operations and development of our school.
