School report of December

1. Teachers' professional development

- a. Mr. Cheng Chung Hang attended the Advanced Course on Catering for Different Learning Needs from 21 November to 13 December.
- b. On 6 December, our school arranged for Educational Psychologist Miss Chan Sau Yan to hold a theme talk on students with special educational needs for our teachers.
- c. Our Principal and Mr. Wong Kam On paid a visit to Shantou Schools for education exchange on 18 and 19 December.

2. Students' whole-person development

- a. On 6 December, our school held the annual Sports Day in Kwai Chung Sports Ground. On that day, the weather was good and many students had the chance to participate in the competition. The event was supported by many parents. There were also kindergartens participating in a kindergarten competition held by our school.
- b. Our school holds 'The Bright Smiles Campus Programme'. Some senior grade students (P.4-6) have been nominated to be trained as Bright Smiles Ambassadors. On 7 December, a half-day leadership training workshop was given to equip the Ambassadors with presentation skill and basic oral care techniques. These Ambassadors will be commissioned to promote the I WILL BRUSH Activity to the P.1 to P.3 students in school to encourage them to brush their teeth thoroughly clean on their own initiative.
- c. From 11 December to 18 December, English team from our school held a series of Christmas activities. Through the activities, students knew more about western festival and culture, learnt different English vocabulary and communicated with English.
- d. On 19 December, our school held the first fire drill in this school year.
- e. On 20 December, the Christmas Party was held in our school. There were variety performances and lucky draw in the hall and there were games and parties in the classrooms.

3. Parent-school cooperation

- a. On 7 December, our Parent-Teacher Association held the first 'Dukling' 'Classroom Aboard' learning activity. Dukling is the only original Chinese junk remaining in Hong Kong. This antique junk is not just a memory of all Hong Kong people, but also an icon of Hong Kong and representing Hong Kong. This activity let students walk outside the classrooms and explore and experience the fishing culture.
- b. On 9 December, our school arranged a seminar for secondary schools discretionary places admission issues for P6 students and parents.
- c. On 13 December, Miss Poon Yuk Chi and parent volunteers visited the factory of lunch supplier and observed the production process of lunch. They were satisfied with the hygiene of the factory, and the nutrients, quantity and temperature of the food.
- d. On 16 December, the parent-teacher association conducted a meeting, discussing affairs of the association and the annual travelling.
