School report of January

- 1. Teachers' professional development
- a. Ms. Tsui Chi Lai and Ms. Lam Wai Yan attended the Foundation Course on Catering for Different Learning Needs, from 6 to 10 January, and from 13 to 17 January respectively.
- b. On 8 January, our vice-principal Ms. Ko Ka Foon, Mr. Ho Hing Wing and Ms. Wong Chuk Kwan attended a seminar on legal issues related to handling school campus conflicts and school affairs.
- c. On 9 January, our teaching staff attended a workshop on positive education held by Miss Chan Sau Yan, who explained how to apply positive education to our daily classroom management.
- d. On 10 January, our teaching staff attended a talk on technology education. In the talk, a professional organization invited by the school introduced to our teachers how to apply artificial intelligence to teaching and learning.

2. Students' all-round development

- a. On 14 January, Hong Kong Council on Smoking and Health held a school interactive education theatre at our school. Our students participated actively and learnt seriously when watching the drama. Through the interactive theatre, students could enhance their knowledge or awareness of the negative effects of smoking, how to say no to smoking and how to quit smoking.
- b. On 15 January, our P1 to P4 students participated in the booth games on the 'Putonghua Thematic Learning Day'. The games were related to daily lives, and let students not just learn Putonghua, but also enhance their initiative in speaking Putonghua.
- c. On 16 January, the Physical Education team of our school arranged a 'School Physical Fitness Day for students from each year level. Different tests enhanced students' motivation to exercise, and helped them understand more about their body condition.
- d. On 17 January, the Physical Education team arranged a talk on rope skipping and the health of heart. In the activity there were interactive sessions letting students experience the joy of rope skipping.
- e. On 20 January, the Physical Education team arranged a talk about Olympics for P2 to P4 students.
- f. On 20 & 21 January, P1 to P4 students participated in the General Studies Thematic Learning Day. They had a paper airplane flying competition. Students learn the different airplane parts, building and improving their paper airplanes.
- g. On 21 January, Our school invited Shakespeare4All to have a drama performance for P3 students. It's a dynamic and stimulating theatre experience for students to explore the senses through a simple story. Students learnt through shadows, body movements and vocal acoustics to experience the imaginative power of theatre.
- h. The visual arts works of our students are praised in the community. After our students' works have been displayed in the Tsuen Wan Town Hall, our school also arranges Visual Arts Works Exhibition on tour, displaying our students' works in different estates and shopping centres in Tsing Yi.

3. Parent-school cooperation

- a. On 12 January, our school held a carnival cum open day. On that day, many parents came to our school with their children to participate. Students were very interested in different booth games and activities related to Chinese New Year.
- b. On 15 January, our school held a Potted Plants Charity Sale. Many students and parents supported the activity, purchasing the potted plant, or making direct donation, helping the needy in our society. We raised \$9680 in this activity.
