School report of June

1. Teachers' professional development

- a. On 4 June, P3 Chinese teachers attained lessons preparation sessions with the supporting officer from EDB.
- b. On 8 June, P4 Math teachers attained lessons preparation sessions with the supporting officer from HKU.
- c. Mr. Lam Hiu Fung attended a Course named Certificate in Professional Development Programme for Teachers of English from 17 to 23 June. The theme is supporting English language learners with reading difficulties.
- d. On 23 & 30 June, our consultant, Dr. Tang Mei Sin had implemented class observation. After the lessons, she had a co-planning meeting with our P1 to 3 teachers, and gave precious opinions to improve the teaching effectiveness for the forthcoming lessons.
- e. On 24 June, five teachers attained Coolthink@JC Zoom Briefing on Web Portal.

2. Students' all-round development

- a. Facing the continuous occurrence of the confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Hong Kong, students will unavoidably become worried, stressed and agonized. As students are mostly home bound during class suspension and have had few social activities, it will take time to rebuild their daily routine. On 15 June, teachers from the guidance team arranged a video for the students to watch. They prepared a sheet for students to express their feelings. Class teachers, subject teachers and our social worker, Ms. Cheung paid attention to the emotional and behavioural changes of our students. Ms. Cheung provided emotional support when necessary.
- b. On 30 June, display of the national flag and the regional flag, and the playing and singing of the national anthem were arranged in every classroom. It's for students to learn to understand its history and spirit as well as observe the etiquette for playing and singing the national anthem. It helps enhance students' sense of national identity.

On 3 June, Parents took P1 students back to school to have them get vaccination for measles, mumps, German measles and chicken pox. P5 girls also get a vaccination for Human Papilloma Virus, HPV.
