Recent school report

- 1. Teachers' professional development:
- a. Our school would arrange the photo-taking of each class every year. However, some students failed to return to school to take the photos because of the epidemic this school year. Each class teacher designed the class photo to let students have good memories.
- b. Because of the epidemic, the school started the summer vacation earlier. The school webpage "Suspension of Classes and Non-stop Learning Area" uploads some learning materials and summer homework for different subjects, so that students can refresh their past learning while staying at home. At the same time, the teachers of each class also summarized the whole-year learning and explained the arrangements of summer homework.
- c. After voting by all students and teachers, Miss Ko Ka Foon and Miss Fu Xiaomei were nominated as the teachers praised in the 25th Teacher Award Program. They will attend the Teacher's Day Celebration and Certificate of Appreciation on 4 November.

2. Students' all-round development

- a. On 4 July, the school held alumni ball game, inviting past graduates and students of the school to participate. On the day of the event, the principal presided over the ceremony of this year's alumni association. The past graduates also shared their outstanding achievements in various industries, which benefited the students a lot. The school also arranged alumni ball games, so that a group of teachers and students had fun together.
- b. In order to enhance students' awareness of disaster prevention and response to the epidemic, the school arranged a musical performance on the theme of disaster prevention for students to enjoy on 7 July. Through the lively and interesting content, students can understand the truth of "There is no specific time for disasters and we should get ready for the prevention."
- c. On 7 July, secondary places allocation results were released, with our P6 students being able to get into their target secondary schools. Nearly 80% of our students were allocated to their top three choices. Nearly 80% of our students were allocated to their first choices.
- d. On 10 July, it was our school's Graduation Ceremony. Mr. Chu officiated the ceremony. Various academic prizes and graduation certificates were awarded to our graduates.
- e. On 10 July, all P6 students attended the Teacher Appreciation Lunch gathering to express their thanks to all the teachers. From the gathering, students not just learnt to respect their teachers, but also learnt how to appropriately express their thankfulness to those who care for and love them.
- f. In this year, our school won the 'Caring School Award' jointly sponsored by the Hong Kong Christian Service and the Hong Kong Association of Careers Masters and Guidance Maters and co-organized by the Hong Kong Education Bureau-the 'Caring School Award Scheme'. This is an encouragement and recognition of joint efforts.
- g. During summer holiday, students recorded videos of "Show and Tell" Some students' work are creative and people can watch their videos in the school website.
- h. On 25 & 27 August, the Primary One (P.1) students had the online bridging classes to let students know the rules and requirement of Chinese, English & Math teachers and get them familiar with the school environment and the school life in our school.
- i. On 1 September, we had a different opening ceremony. The school took the video of the opening ceremony in advance and students participated in it through the Zoom.
- j. 10 September is Teachers' Day. Our school received videos and greeting cards from students to teachers to express their respect and gratitude to the principal and teachers.
- k. On 21 & 22 September, we organized Bridging classes for P1 students. Teachers talked about the rules and reminded students what they need to do in the school.

3. Parent-school cooperation

- a. The third Incorporated Management Committee meeting was conducted on 11 July.
- b. On 15 August, our school held a video conference to answer the parents' questions about the arrangements for the new school year.
- c. On 18 August, our school organized a meeting for new students and their parents through the Zoom. Principal Chow introduced new teachers, classroom arrangements, e-learning matters to parents and answered their questions.
- d. This school year, our school adopt eClass Junior integrated platform for online learning and teaching, school administration and interactive communication.
- e. Our school is going to participate in Community Care Fund Assistance Programme Provision of Subsidy to Needy Primary and Secondary Students for Purchasing Mobile Computer Devices to Facilitate the Practice of e-Learning.

- f. On 19 September, we were honoured to have Dr. Tang Mei Sin who delivered a talk titled "To Learning English Effectively" to parents. The participants were positive towards the seminar. On the same day, we held a seminar for P1 parents. Many parents came on that day and they gave positive feedback and opinion. This reflects the recognition and support of the school from our parents.
