## Circular on Top-up Grant for Supporting Online Learning of Financially Needy Students

Due to the presence of the COVID-19 virus, students who cannot have face-to-face lessons need to have e-learning at home. Some students cannot acquire appropriate Internet services because of the limitations of their living environment (such as living in sub-divided houses, old buildings or remote areas). The Education Bureau arranges schools to purchase portable wireless network routers and mobile data cards for students in need so that they can conduct e-learning at home. The school would like to know the situation of students' online e-learning at home. (According to the guidelines of the Education Bureau, our schools should ensure the subsidy is used properly. Therefore, when necessary, our school will collect further information from applicants.)
