

Dear parents of P.4-P.6 students,

Circular on implementing the “Bring Your Own Device” (BYOD) policy for e-learning (and Community Care Fund Assistance Programme)

To further promote e-learning so as to improve the learning efficiency of students, our school will implement the “Bring Your Own Device” (BYOD) policy for e-learning. Every student needs to use their own mobile devices at school for e-learning. To assist students from low-income families to buy the mobile computer devices, our school is now arranging students receiving CSSA, full grant or half grant of the School Textbook Assistance Scheme, to apply for the Community Care Fund Assistance Programme. The subsidy amount is only used to pay the actual cost of the mobile computer device. After the procurement process, the school will entrust "HKT Education Limited" as the supplier. The prices are as follows:

Benefitting students must purchase all the above items through our school's procurement process. Otherwise, no subsidies will be provided. Also, CSSA students must provide relevant supporting documents for the verification to class teachers on or before 15th December, 2020.

Non- benefitting students must purchase all the above items if they order the devices through our school or buy the devices by other ways.

Parents do not need to pay any fees at this stage. Our school will arrange a demonstration by the supplier for parents. Details as follows:
