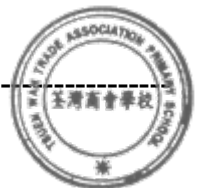

School report of January

1. Teachers' professional development

- a. On 2 December, all teachers attended a talk about education issues related to National Security Law and legal issues related to online teaching.
- b. On 13 January, the principal, the vice principal and senior teachers participated in a seminar on legal issues related to copyright, campus personnel management and legal responsibilities.
- c. From 19 to 22 January, Ms. Tam Sze Wah participated in the Special Educational Needs Coordinator's Professional Development Course of professional training to support students with special education needs.
- d. In order to promote the sports atmosphere in the school, our school has provided the opportunities for students to participate in sports activities from different areas. Through the SportACT award programme organized by the Leisure and Cultural Services Department, students can develop the habit of self-recording the daily exercise hours. Our school won the "Vitality Campus Award" in this project, affirming our school's efforts to promote sports culture.

2. Students' all-round development

- a. Our school participates in the "One Person, One Flower" Scheme organized by the Leisure and Cultural Services Department every year. The students took the Dianthus flower home and planted it. After more than a month, many students have planted the plants. The teachers encouraged the students to take photos of the plants to let other classmates share the happiness and appreciate each other. The activity allows students to understand we can have good results from their caring.
- b. On 8 January, a talk called "Transforming Pressure to Strength" for students was prepared by a social worker from the Baptist Aiqun Social Service Office, hoping that through the presentation of positive methods for dealing with stress, the students could master some skills to deal with stress and strengthen their ability in problem-solving and resilience, and cultivate a positive and optimistic attitude among them.
- c. On 18 January, our school invited the tutors of the Hong Kong Music Office to have the music performance. Students could not only enjoy the music performance, but also learn about the percussion, woodwind and brass instruments.
- d. To protect the spine, chiropractors recommend that we do 20 minutes of chiropractic exercises every day. The teachers have also made efforts to promote the "Hong Kong-wide Chiropractic" of the Children's Chiropractic Fund, and filmed clips to teach students how to do the actions. In this month, teachers demonstrated the first group of 3 actions, which are called Anti-Door Star, Twisted Star and Bouncing Star.
- e. On 29 January, Dr. Tam, the Chairman of the Alumni Association, came to our school to conduct an interview workshop for primary six students. He is a current secondary school teacher who is responsible for handling Secondary One admission matters in his school. In that workshop, he gave students many practical interview skills.

3. Parent-school cooperation

- a. In order to help those families who have limited economic means at present to have e-learning at home, our school made use of the Top-up Grant for Supporting Online Learning of Financially Needy Students, to help 20 students to purchase portable wireless network routers and mobile data cards. We also helped two students to apply for free notebooks and a 3-month tutorial service to help learning via the scheme organized by Kwai Tsing District Office.
- b. On 19 December, Parent-Teacher Association had their first meeting to discuss about the development of PTA and plans for the activities of the upcoming days.
- c. On 12 January, our school held the second "CEO Parents" lecture on positive family for parents. Parents participated in a lecture entitled "Six Virtues for Cultivating Children" and learned about the six virtues "Perseverance", "Respect for others", "Responsibility", "Spirit of commitment",

“Integrity” and “Caring” for children's growth, to understand how to cultivate children's good character to enhance students' resilience.

- d. 25 January was the polling day for the parent manager election of the Incorporated Management Committee. Parents all voted enthusiastically to elect the new parent manager and replacement parent manager. 4D Wu Lok Yin's father and 4B Liu Xuan Ting's mother were elected respectively.
- e. At the start of this new year, our students are reminded of evaluating their performances in the past and setting priorities as to how to do and learn better in the new year. A calendar designed by our school was given to P1 students to remind them to have the habit of 'evaluating and planning'.
