Class Arrangements after Chinese New Year Holidays

Class Arrangements for Schools after Chinese New Year Holidays was released by Education Bureau on 5 February 2021. The EDB, after taking into account the latest development of the epidemic, advice of health experts and the preparedness of schools, has decided that all primary schools should be allowed to arrange more students to return to campuses on a half-day basis in accordance with school-based circumstances after the schools' Chinese New Year's holidays, with the number of students capped at one-third of the total number of students of the schools.

Primary 1 and 6 students will attend school as before the holiday. Our school will also arrange students of Primary 4 and 5 to return to school for on campus learning in the morning starting from 22 February. The class arrangements for Primary 2 and 3 students would be announced later. Our school would continue to put in place the preventive measures stipulated in "Health Protection Measures for Schools" issued by the EDB and "Health Advice to Schools for the Prevention of COVID-19" issued by the Centre for Health Protection. Such measures include wearing masks all the time within school campuses, maintaining appropriate social distances, measuring temperatures of teachers and students at school entrances, etc. They are to safeguard the health of the teachers and students.
