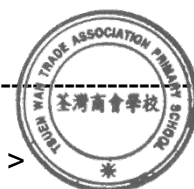

School report of March

1. Teachers' professional development

- a. On March 3, all Mathematics teachers participated in the online Mathematics teaching seminar.
- b. On March 9 and 30, P.1-P.4 English teachers had a lesson preparation meeting with our school's support consultant Dr. Dang.
- c. On March 17, three P.1 Chinese teachers participated in Tiered Intervention Model in junior levels to have P.1 Optimizing Teaching Seminar.
- d. On March 24, P.4 Mathematics teacher had a co-planning meeting with Mr. Wu, the local support consultant of Mathematics.

2. Students' all-round development

- a. Our school provided children's emotional education lectures on March 3 and 12 respectively for senior primary and junior primary school students. Students learned how to properly handle their own and others' negative emotions, to correct misunderstandings about emotions and to establish a positive attitude.
- b. March 14 can be expressed as 3.14, which is just an approximation of pi, and many people call this day "Pi Day". The Mathematics teachers arranged various interesting activities related to circles in the covered playground for all levels during the recess from March 8 to 12, so that students could learn about circles.
- c. In order to cultivate students' interest in visual arts and celebrate the arrival of the Chinese New Year, Visual Arts teachers held a creative design competition to welcome the new year. Students were free to design creative New Year decorations with "cow" as the theme. The students created many outstanding works.
- d. In order to allow students to use their talents through the competition, Music teachers held the "Singing Competition 2021". The students actively participated in the filming to show the singing voice. In the film, we could see that the students enjoyed the fun of music.
- e. In order to promote our school's sports culture and atmosphere, and encourage students to maintain appropriate physical activity during the epidemic, our school participated in the Epidemic Challenge-Home Physical Fitness Challenge Programme. The P.E. teachers filmed four different types of simple home exercise clips, allowing students to watch the clips and follow them to exercise at home. Our school also arranged for students to do exercises with their physical education teachers after class through real-time video, to implement "Tsuen" people movement! The teachers' participation not only enhances the students' motivation to do sports, but also improves the accuracy of the movements.
- f. On March 30, our school arranged more than 20 environmental ambassadors to participate in the OCEAN STEM tour of Hoi Ha Wan in Sai Kung. Students experienced the beautiful nature through the practice of cleaning the coast, personally experienced the importance of protecting the coast, and explored how to use the creativity of STEM to encourage "reducing waste at the source".

3. Parent-school cooperation

- a. On March 20, P.4-P.5 students and their parents who participated in the Understanding the Adolescent Project went to Kam Tin Country Club to participate in the parent-child day camp. The activity promotes the communication and understanding between parents and children, allowing them to experience the principle of "love to be close", to appreciate each other and to encourage each other. There were different activities on that day. Parents and students had a fulfilling and enjoyable day.

Every school year, the school will make collection from students for specific purposes based on the guidance given by Education Bureau to compensate part of the spending on overall learning activities every year.
