School report of April

- 1. Teachers' professional development
- a. On April 22, our school teachers Mr. S.L. Lee, Mr. H. Zhong, Miss C.K. Wong, Miss H.P. Yu and Mr. C.C. Mong who participated in the Coolthink project had a co-planning meeting with the Jockey Club Computational Thinking Education Project (Coolthink) team from the Educational Technology Centre of The Education University of Hong Kong at the school. They had the lesson observation, discussion and shared different teaching methods and experiences.
- b. On April 23, Chinese teachers held the eighth lesson preparation meeting for the Chinese teaching support scheme for junior primary schools.
- c. On April 23, all mathematics teachers participated in the "Journey on Learning in Action" seminar.
- d. From April 27 to 30, Miss Tam attended the fourth course of the Special Education Needs Coordinator Professional Development Course (2019/21).
- 2. Students' all-round development
- a. April 15th is the National Security Education Day. Our school conducted a series of different activities on that day to raise students' understanding of Hong Kong's national security law. Activities included the "raising the national flag and playing the national anthem" ceremony and the principal's speech, watching audiobooks 'You and I should know about the National Security' and showing the thematic exhibition board. Also, our school invites students to participate in the 2021 "National Security Education Day" online quiz competition and so on. Our school hopes students understand the importance of national security to the country, the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region and every Hong Kong citizen.
- b. On April 16, our school arranged for P.3 to P.6 students to participate in the "Film Exploration and Innovation Programme- Animation". It was organized by the Film Program Office of the Leisure and Cultural Services Department. During the activity, tutors conducted lively and interesting demonstrations and small activities to let students understand the history and production principles of animation. Students even used tablets to create and shoot stop motion animations.
- c. On April 17, Pong Pui Chiu, a student of our school's violin class, attended a concert in the "Jockey Club Power of Music Programme". Also, he played the violin with students from other schools in the Concert Hall of the Hong Kong City Hall. The song was Ode To Joy. This event will not only allow students from our school and other schools to learn from each other, but also let them learn some performance skills and improve musical standards through an ensemble with professional musicians.
- d. On April 20, our school invited the string group of instructors from the Hong Kong Music Office to the school to perform a string concert called "Music for the Millions". The students not only appreciated music performances, which deepened their understanding of music performances and string music, but also learned about the violin, viola, cello and double bass.
- e. April 23 is World Reading Day. Our school library teachers held a reading month activity to allow students to develop an interest in reading through multiple reading activities. A series of activities will be held this year, including book promotions, e-book reading fun, "When the Story Becomes a Reality" Detective Theater, "Different Fairy Tale Ending" Story Rewriting Competition, Children's Book Writer Sharing Session and other activities to encourage students to read enthusiastically and promote a reading culture.
- f. On April 21st and 23rd, our school arranged a theatre "Rule of Law through Drama" which was organised by the Hong Kong Drama Education Studio and the Department of Justice. It is hoped that through lively and interesting drama performances and live interactions, we will cultivate the correct concept of the rule of law and establish the spirit of law-abiding citizens in the primary school students.

- 3. Parent-school cooperation
- a. The "Bright Smile Campus Programme" has been implemented for a while. Our school hopes that every student will establish a daily teeth-cleaning and regular eating habits. To develop these good habits, family cooperation is indispensable. Our school hopes that with the cooperation of parents, everyone can become teeth-loving angels.
- b. To encourage students to engage in appropriate physical activities at home during the epidemic, and to promote the culture and atmosphere of sports, P.E. teachers showed four different types of simple home exercise clips for students to let them see how to do exercise at home. Also, the partner-style home exercise is very suitable for classmates and parents to do together. It is not only good for the body, but also promotes the parent-child relationship.
