## School report of October

1. Teachers' professional development:
  - a. In order to improve the quality of teaching and learning, our Mathematics consultant, Mr. Ng Pui Wing has school-based co-planning meetings with P.5 Mathematics teachers weekly from September, 2021 to June, 2022.
  - b. Ms. Cheung Ka Man and Ms. Tsang Wai Sheung attended the Chinese Tiered Intervention Model training workshop on 6<sup>th</sup> October, 2021.
  - c. Ms. Tsui Chi Lai attended a professional programme for Special Educational Needs Coordinator (2021/22) from 25<sup>th</sup> October to 29<sup>th</sup> October, 2021.
  
2. Students' all-round development
  - a. Our school attaches great importance to health education and was awarded the "Certified Chiropractic School" award this school year. The Chiropractic School Project is organized by the Children's Chiropractic Foundation. It aims to increase students and parents awareness of the importance of spinal nerve health.
