## School report of November

### 1. Teachers' professional development

- a. On November 3-5 & 11-12, Principal K.H.Chow participates in the Leadership Advancement Programme for Experienced Principals.
- b. On November 9 & 23, our school advisor, Dr. Tang Mei Sin, had her regular lesson observation and training workshops with our English teachers.
- c. On November 3 & 24, our Mathematics consultant, Mr. Ng Pui Wing had school-based co-planning meetings with P.5 Mathematics teachers in order to improve the quality of teaching and learning.

### 2. Students' all-round development

- a. After working hard on daily practice, the school's Sport Team did their best in Tsing Yi District Inter-school athletics matches on November 1. Their work hard work paid off and they had good results.
