School report, December

1. Teachers' professional development

- a. Ms. Cheung Ka Man attended the Thematic Course on Catering for Different Learning Needs from 29th November to 10th December. This Thematic Course aims at enhancing teacher's competency in teaching students with 'Behavioural, Emotional and Social Development Needs' (BESDN), focusing on the needs of students with Autistic Spectrum Disorder (ASD) and mental health problems.
- b. Ms. Tsui Chi Lai attended the Core Programme - "Professional Conduct, Values and Education Policies" on 6th December which aimed at enhancing teacher's understanding of the education policies, the Constitution and the Basic Law.

2. Students' whole-person development

- a. To enhance students' understanding of the Constitution, the Basic Law and national security, the school organised a series of activities, including board displays, a quiz contest and an online quiz on "National Constitution Day 2021" organised by the Education Bureau. In the morning assembly on 3rd December, all teachers and students participated in the national flag raising ceremony, sang the national anthem and watched a video to learn more about the Constitution of the People's Republic of China.
- b. On 4th December, our school launched the "Pillars of Tomorrow: the second phase joint school activities of the Chinese History Education and Training Scheme for Young People, with four kindergartens. Dr. Hui Shing Yan, Chief Curriculum Support Officer (All-round Learning) of the Education Bureau, Mr. Ho Hon Kuen, Principal of the Chinese History Education Centre, and Dr. Yau Kwok Kwong, Chief Executive Officer of the Chinese History Education Centre were the guests of honour. On the same day, our students, who graduated from the four participating kindergartens, acted as historical figures at the launching ceremony. Together with our student host, they performed very well in the ceremony and were appreciated by many guests.
- c. From 14th to 21st December, the English Department held a series of Christmas activities. Through these activities, students learnt more about the western festival and culture. Students also learnt some festive English vocabulary and enjoyed the fun game booths.
- d. On 16th December, our school held the Education Theatre programme "Smoke-free Detective Adventure" to promote smoke-free messages.
- e. On 22nd December, the Christmas Party was held in our school. There was a variety show and a lucky draw in the hall and there were games and parties in the classrooms.

- a. Principal Chow Kim Ho and Ms. Poon Yuk Chi supervise our lunch service supplier's performance to ensure the hygiene, nutrition, quantities and temperature of the lunch boxes regularly in November, 2021.
