Circular on Top-up Grant for Supporting Online Learning of Financially Needy Students

Due to the presence of the COVID-19 virus, students who cannot have face-to-face lessons need to learn via e-learning at home. Some students cannot acquire appropriate internet services because of the limitations of their living environment (living in sub-divided houses, old buildings or remote areas). The Education Bureau arranges schools to purchase portable wireless network routers and then lend them to the above students, and/or provide them with mobile data cards to study at home. Students need to return the portable wireless router to the school at the end of the scheme or after graduation, so we can lend it to other students in need. Our school would like to know more about students' online e-learning situation. According to the guidelines of the Education Bureau, our school should ensure the subsidy is used properly. Therefore, when necessary, our school will collect further information from applicants.
