School report, March & April

1. Teacher Professional Development

- a. From 10th to 25th February, Miss Lam Wai Yan participated in an advanced course for Catering for Learner Diversity, to explore various students' special needs, assess the effectiveness of learning support and intervention strategies, review, plan and review the special learning needs of students in school.
- b. On 27th April, all teachers participated in the Mental Health Promotion Workshop. Teachers acquired basic knowledge and skills to identify, care for and support students with mental health needs early.

2. Holistic Development of students

- a. Students were vaccinated at Cheung Heng Community Hall on 6th March. Principal Chow was there to monitor the situation. Many parents and students participated in the fight against the virus. Vaccination is highly effective in preventing severe illness or death in people infected with COVID-19. Vaccination not only reduces the spread of the virus in the community, but also helps students return to normal school and daily life as soon as possible.
- b. On 21st March, the English Drama Team won several awards in the 2022 New Territories West Primary School Drama Contest. In order to ensure the safety of students and aligned with the school's epidemic prevention measures, there was not much time for face-to-face training, but parents were still very supportive, and students did their best to practice, do rehearsals and perform online. During the suspension period, students practiced at home and performed online. The students were very cooperative and enthusiastic. The school is glad to see that students could work under difficult circumstances to maximize their potential.

3. Home-school Cooperation

- a. The 2nd SMC Meeting was held on 30th April. The Supervisor, the Sponsoring Body Manager and the parent representative shared their opinions on the policies and measures of the school and provided guidance for the operation and development of the school.
- b. Each year, the school collects approved fees as part of the overall learning expenses of students in accordance with the guidelines of the Education Bureau. As of the last academic year, the balance was \$98,025.52, as shown on the school website.
- c. Parents are requested to check their children's temperature and complete a Rapid Antigen Test (RAT) each day before returning to school. They should sign the record form and take a photo of the RAT results for checking when necessary. If any student or their family member confirm the diagnosis of COVID-19, they have to inform the school immediately, the school will then formulate contingency measures.
