## School report, September

### 1. Teacher Professional Development

- a. In order to improve the quality of teaching and learning, our Mathematics consultant, Mr. Ng, had school-based co-planning meetings with P.6 Mathematics teachers on 6<sup>th</sup> September, 2022.
- b. On 16<sup>th</sup> September, the school held a professional development workshop for all teachers. Through the team-building activities, the positive relationship among teachers were strengthened.

### 2. Holistic Development of students

- a. On 5<sup>th</sup> September, the school launched a ceremony to start the “Big Brothers and Big Sisters” Scheme. It aims to let the senior form students assist P.1 students to adapt to their new school lives. This scheme also helps promote Positive Education on the school campus.
- b. On 16<sup>th</sup> September, our school held our Sports Day in Tsing Yi Sports Ground. The annual school event, which was cancelled due to the pandemic in the past two years, has been held as scheduled this year. Many parents came to support their children and watch the races. Students, teachers and parents were thrilled to participate in the school event.
- c. To enhance students' creativity and presentation skills, the school arranged a LEGO Creative Workshop for students on 21<sup>st</sup> September. During the activity, students used LEGO blocks to build models related to their daily life experience and presented their creative ideas.

- a. During September, the school campus was opened for kindergarten parents' visits. They could learn more about the school-based curriculum, the bilingual courses and also the enriched English learning environment.
