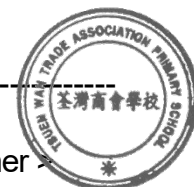

School report of November

1. Teachers' professional development

- a. On 18th November, all teachers participated in a professional development workshop organised by the school's educational psychologist Ms. Choi Man Nga on the production of hierarchical worksheets and questioning skills for students with educational needs.

2. Students' all-round development

- a. After routine training, our students tried their best to achieve good results in competitions. The students made great achievements in this year's inter-school track and field competition and got the best result ever -- eight gold medals, six silver medals and two bronze medals.
- b. On 10th November, we held a film appreciation activity to promote positive education with inspirational films and inject more positive energy into the students. On the same day, parents, students and teachers enjoyed the movie "Find Your Voice" together. The movie tells the story of troubled students, who get a chance to grow up and find themselves in music. The plot is inspirational and touching, we all watched with relish.
- c. In order to allow students to have healthy outdoor learning activities and experience the fun of community life, our school held an outdoor learning Day on 11th November with the participation of parents. P. 1 to P.3 students visited Kowloon Park and P.4 to P. 6 students went to Pak Tam Chung Country Park. Group activities brought students together, let them get out of the classroom, to learn some communication and cooperation skills. Students had a complete and meaningful day.
- d. From 8th to 16th November, the school held a series of activities on understanding Chinese historical figures, including a short video on understanding Chinese dynasties and understanding Chinese historical figures. From the activities, students learned about the contributions of Chinese historical figures to the country and social culture, and their interests in learning national history were enhanced.
- e. Our school and Yan Chai Hospital Zonta Club of Kowloon Kindergarten joined the "Pillars of Tomorrow: National History Education Programme for Young People" on 18th November for the second phase of the joint school activity. In this activity, our P.1 students participated in the pottery workshop with the kindergarten students to learn about this ancient Chinese culture and art. Campus reporters also walked around the kindergarten, covering the day of the joint school activities. The activity enhanced the children's awareness and interest in pottery.

3. Parent-school cooperation

- a. The first term's Parents' Day was held on 25th November. Class teachers and parents communicated to talk about the overall performance of our students.
- b. Starting December, the school will resume whole-day face-to-face classes. The school will have rooms to provide a variety of sports, social and extra-curricular activities for our students.
