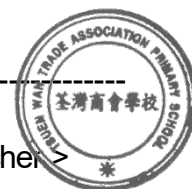

## School report, December

### 1. Teachers' professional development

- a. On 6th December, Vice Principal Ko Ka Foon, Mr. Liu Shui Ka, Mr. Ng Ka Lee and Ms. Cheung Yan Ting attended Tsing Yi Primary School's Teacher Development Day and participated in a talk on "School Crisis Management" to enhance their understanding of the topic.
- b. On 14th and 21st December, P.5 Chinese teachers held a Chinese School-based Support Programme joint lesson preparation meeting and teaching workshop.

### 2. Students' whole-person development

- a. Sports Promotion Month is held in December to bring different sports experiences and competitions to P. 1 to P.3 students. The activity was held from 14:15 to 15:15 during the multiple intelligence class period. Students experienced activities and competitions such as dodging plate, skipping rope, floorball and football. The students were engaged in the activities.
- b. The monthly Award Presentation Ceremony was held on 1st December. A number of awards and certificates were presented to outstanding students.
- c. P.5 students participated in a 3-day, 2-night education camp in Cheung Chau from 7th to 9th December. Through the Cheung Chau Community Search, Cheung Po Tsai Cave exploration, astronomy exploration, sand-sculpture competition, barbecue party, environmental projects, competitive games and other activities, students learnt interpersonal skills and developed self-care and self-reliance.
- d. The school held a birthday party on 9th December for students whose birthdays fall from September to December. Students celebrated their birthdays with their teachers and classmates. They also expressed their gratitude, thanks to their teachers' and parents' love.
- e. The school's history education activities were held last month, including learning about different Chinese dynasties, historical figures, costumes of different dynasties and the election of historical figures. We were honored to win the Best Promotion Award (Silver Award) and the Active Voting Award from the Chinese History Education Centre (Hong Kong). On 20th December the school was represented at the "Annual Chinese Historical Figures Election Results and Award Presentation Ceremony" at Hong Kong PolyU. The Video Arts Group also participated in the "Making New Clothes for Historical Figures" design competition. Our school won the most Active School Participation Award and 1A Wan Tin Chun won the Preliminary Group Merit Award.
- f. From 20th to 21st December, the English Department organized various Christmas celebration activities. Students learned to sing Christmas songs and to make crafts and snacks. They also learnt more about Christmas vocabulary and, most importantly, that they had to share their love with others.
- g. Our school holds a Christmas party every year and arranges students to perform in a talent show. Many students signed up to participate in performances such as, singing, dancing and playing musical instruments.

### 3. Parent-school cooperation

- a. The school planned a 2-hour preparatory course for Primary 1 students in December for three consecutive weekends. The course included a course on understanding and controlling emotions through games, learning gifted elements and English games. The children studied together, sang songs and played games, and they quickly adapted to their new learning environment. They were engaged, and spent meaningful time learning with laughter.
- b. On 7th December, a parent seminar for P.6 students and their parents was held to let parents know about the mechanism for secondary schools' allocation. On the same day, the Assistant Principal of Wai Kiu College was invited to introduce secondary school life to the students and

their parents.

- c. On 21st December, the chairman of Alumni Association and the Alumni Manager of our school, Dr. Tam Lap Kee, hold a talk for P.6 students to let them know about the differences between government schools, aided schools, and schools under Direct Subsidy Scheme. He pointed out some important items for P.6 students to notice for preparing the school interviews.
