## School report, March

## 1. Teachers' professional development

- a. On 1st March, the Principal and Mr. Lee Sheung Lok attended the 60th anniversary event of "Learning from Lei Feng" at Shenzhen Luohu Primary School, our sister school, to learn how it has applied Lei Feng's spirit of selfless dedication and service to moral education.
- b. On 31st March, P. 6 Chinese teachers held a co-planning meeting for preparing teaching materials for students.

### 2. Students' all-round development

- a. The school has arranged for students to participate in the "Smart City Smart Hong Kong" roving Exhibition organized by the Office of the Government Chief Information Officer on 2nd March. During the activity, students experienced Hong Kong 3D digital map, intelligent zebra crossing, smart airport, easy boarding, easy travel, virtual customs ambassador system, etc. Students had an understanding of different smart facilities, and experienced first-hand how new technologies facilitate daily life.
- b. P.4 students participated in the Cycling Safety Training Programme organized by the Road Safety Council on 2nd March. Students learned about the causes and elements of cycling accidents through experience activities to avoid traffic accidents. Professionals were invited to the school to explain the importance of safety equipment and how to select, check and adjust cycling equipment.
- c. On 4th March, the school participated in the Hong Kong Playground Association's Flag Selling fundraising activity. 22 students participated in the flag selling on that day. By participating in community service activities, students develop a caring mind and enhance their communication skills.
- d. The monthly Presentation ceremony on 9th March was held smoothly. A number of awards and certificates were presented in the academic, sports and arts categories.
- e. Gymnastics school team members have improved their physical and technical levels after a semester of training and learning. The school arranged an open training session for the school gymnastics team on 11th March to let parents know about the students' learning progress and to provide training opportunities for the school gymnastics team members to prepare for the competitions.
- f. Hoy TV Hong Kong filmed a program about students in our school on 27th March. Students of different grades were invited to answer questions from the host. The students were very enthusiastic and students of all ages were able to show their creativity and communication skills.
- g. On 30th March, our school organised the Chinese Culture Day. The event provided students opportunities to learn about the long history of Chinese culture and arts, including calligraphy, riddles, stories etc.

### 3. Home-school cooperation

- a. On 15th March, the school held an Outstanding Achievement Award (I) Prize Presentation to recognize students who have made fantastic achievements in external competitions and individual performances. A total of 120 parents attended the ceremony. Apart from taking photos with their children on the stage, the ceremony also featured performances and shared messages from the students, parents and teachers. After the ceremony, the winning students, their parents and teachers joined in the celebration tea party and enjoyed a happy time together.
- b. On 25th March, students and parents of our school attended a dance performance called "The Way of Dancing" at the Hong Kong Cultural Centre. "Dance Painting" gives our school teachers, students and parents visual enjoyment. The dancers' beautiful dance gestures match and harmonize with Chinese art and music. The dancers' performances of "Calligraphy and landscape dancing" and "Self, others and nature dancing" make us feel the artistic conception of the unity of nature and man, and understand the beauty of Chinese art.
