School report, April

1. Teachers' professional development

- a. On 21st April, Ms. Tsui Chi Lai, Ms. Ng Ka Lee and Ms. Cheung Yan Ting attended the Tsing Yi District Primary School Association Teacher Development Activity. They learnt about the concept, benefits and effectiveness of meditation and how to use the resource kit.
- b. From 23rd to 28th April, Mr. Zhong Hui attended the Gala for Gardeners of Chinese Nation. The Secretary for Education, Dr Choi Yuk-lin, led a delegation of Hong Kong principals and teachers to participate this activity in Chongqing. The Gala, with an aim of promoting professional exchanges and co-operation among Chinese education practitioners from across the country and overseas through interaction and sharing, so as to achieve the goal of mutual learning for joint development.

2. Students' all-round development

- a. On 20th April, the school invited the famous international champion magician, Louis Yan, to perform magic, and share his path as a magician. Louis has won the American and European Magic Awards and Magic World Oscar Merlin Award, and set two Guinness World Records. He is also the 2019 winner of Hong Kong's Top 10 Outstanding Young People. On the activity day, Louis invited the students to perform magic and experience the fun of magic. The students were very involved. The programme designed by him was started on 27/4 in our school.
- b. The school participated in the "Pillars of Tomorrow: Chinese History Education Programme for Young People" organized by the Chinese History Education Centre (Hong Kong). From 20th to 22nd April, the participating schools shared their experiences and achievements with the community and held a public exhibition at the Hong Kong Palace Museum. Officiating Guest Mr. Cheung Kwok Kwan, Deputy Secretary for Justice, presented a certificate of appreciation to the school. P.4 students also attended the exhibition on 21st April to learn more about Chinese culture.
- c. On 21st April, the Correctional Services Department (CSD) "Rehabilitation Express" (RehEx) was invited to the school to enhance the promotion of national security, national education and crime prevention. As well as anti-drug and support for rehabilitation messages, P.5 and P.6 students through electronic games and dodgebee, an emerging sport. Students were able to learn more about correct values, cultivating national identity and caring for the country.
- d. On 22nd and 29th April, our school held STEM New Generation Scheme for prospective P.1 students, to let them learn STEM, experience authentic learning and fun activities.

3. Home-school cooperation

- a. On 17th April, the school arranged a talk on central allocation of secondary school places for parents of P.5 and P.6 parents. The placement mechanism, school selection methods and points to note were shared with P.5 and P.6 students and their parents.
- b. On 20th April, the school held a briefing and trial meeting for lunch suppliers. 7 teachers, 14 parents and 9 students participated in the meeting. The parents provided feedback to the school on the quality, hygiene, price and taste of the lunch suppliers. The PTA 2nd meeting held on 28/4 also discussed about this issue.
- c. On 28th April, Parents' Day was held at our school. Parents came to the school and had an interview with the class teacher to discuss their children's learning in school and to strengthen communication and understanding of the students' recent performance. On the same day, Speech Therapist, Ms. Pang, gave a talk to parents on how to identify and improve their children's language ability. Students' work was also exhibited in the activity room. Teachers selected some excellent students' work to show parents and students, so that students could enjoy and learn from each other.
