School report, June

- 1. Teachers' professional development
 - a. On 14th June, Ms. Leung Sze Nga, Ms. Ng Ka Lee, Ms. Kwok Hoi Yan and Mr. Liu Chun Yat participated in the Mediation and Complaint Resolution Seminar. They shared different school cases and relevant legislation to understand the effective use of mediation strategies to deal with campus problems, and promote the collaboration with various stakeholders to build a harmonious campus.
 - b. On 24th June, Mr. Ho Hing Wing and Ms. Ng Ka Lee participated in the Sharing session of the Community of Practice Optimised Small Class Teaching Support Scheme at the Education University of Hong Kong.
- 2. Students' all-round development
 - a. The school organized a fancy rope skipping demonstration and heart health talk for students on 1st June. Through the talk and rope skipping demonstration, students learned about the risk factors of heart disease and prevention methods, encouraged students to take more exercise to establish a healthy lifestyle, reduce the risk of heart disease and stroke, and enjoy the fun of doing exercise.
 - b. The school held a cross-curricular Thanksgiving activity with the theme of Father's Day in mid-June. Together with Chinese Language, English Language, Mathematics and Visual Arts, the Guidance Team allowed students to design, shoot videos and make cards. Students expressed their gratitude through different activities, learning to cherish family and others who care for them.
 - c. On 24th and 25th June, some P.1 to P.3 students attended the Ocean Park Summer Adventure Course to observe and touch sea lions or seals and learn about their physical characteristics. They attended an educational demonstration on sharks and fed the sharks, and explored behind the scenes shark care facilities. It was a great learning experience to deepen students' understanding of animals, marine ecology and conservation.
 - d. On 26th June, the Putonghua Theme Study Day was held. During the day, there were several games for students to review and apply their knowledge of Putonghua pronunciation. The students were all engaged and enjoyed it.
 - e. On 28th June, the school invited the Drama Wonderland "The Masked Family" to warn against the dangers of gambling.
- 3. Home-school cooperation
 - a. A parent-teacher trip was held on 17th June. The day was full of activities, including a tour of Lau Fau Shan Tsim Bei Tsui, viewing Mai Po Deep Bay and Ramsar Wetland, visiting seafood Street and Kam Tin Red brick House, visiting various specialty shops, and enjoying abalone seafood at Lau Fau Shan. Although it rained heavily from time to time, the trip went smoothly and everyone was able to enjoy themselves.
 - b. The school organized a parents' talk on "You are Happy, So Your Children are Happy" on 21st June to let parents understand negative emotions and their impact on their children, so as to strengthen the elements of parent-child relationships. The content of the seminar enables parents to grasp the main points and ways to deal with their children's negative emotions.
 - c. On 28th June, the school conducted a parents' talk on "How to Help children establish good habits through effective communication methods" for parents of Understanding Adolescent Project members in P. 5 and P. 6 and parents of senior secondary students. Ms. Chow Yin Foon and Ms. Lam Suk Man, social workers of the Hong Kong Playground Association, had professionally analysed the mental trap of parents from a variety of perspectives and what is meant by active listening and understanding of the reasons behind their children's behaviour. Parents were happy to share examples of their time with their children, and there was a lot of communication in the process.
