## School report, April

### 1. Teachers' professional development

- a. From 10th to 12th April, Mr. Wong Chi Wai participated in the "2025 Hong Kong Primary and Secondary School Robotics STEAM Technology Curriculum Support and Training Program" in Shen Zhen organized by Professor Shang Huiliang's team from Fudan University.
- b. From 16th to 19th April, the Principal and Ms. Leung Sze Nga participated in the "2025 Qiong-Hong Sister School Signing Ceremony and Study Tour." During this study tour, our school formalized a sister school partnership with Haikou City No. 27 Primary School in Hainan through a signing ceremony. The Principal and Ms. Leung visited the school and engaged in teaching discussions and exchanges. The delegation also conducted study visits to the Leiqiong Haikou Volcanoes Global Geopark, Wenchang Aerospace Supercomputing Science Museum, Haikou Qilou Old Street, and the Hainan Provincial Museum. The aim is to arrange suitable learning opportunities for students in the future, encouraging them to "step out of the campus," broaden their horizons, and deepen their understanding of the motherland's development.

### 2. Students' all-round development

- a. On 5th and 12th our school organized the STEAM New Generation Scheme for prospective primary one students, allowing them to learn STEM, experience school life, and enjoy the fun of training classes.
- b. On 10th April, the school arranged for fourth-grade students to visit the Hong Kong Museum of History, with a special focus on the National Security Exhibition Hall. This is the first dedicated hall in the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region to systematically introduce national security, aiming to help students understand its importance. By observing and reading the exhibition materials, students enhanced their knowledge and understanding of national security and grasped the core concepts of the comprehensive national security framework.
- c. On 15th April, which marked National Security Education Day, our school organized a series of educational activities for students between April 7 and 11. During the morning assembly's flag-raising ceremony and the "Speech Under the National Flag," the purpose, origin, and significance of National Security Education Day were introduced to all teachers and students. Through short films, display boards, and a book exhibition on national security education, students gained a deeper understanding of national security topics. During recess and lunch breaks, quiz games and booth activities were held to help students learn about behaviors related to complying with the National Security Law, the Basic Law, the Constitution, intangible cultural heritage, and the 20 domains of national security. Students actively participated and learned the importance of abiding by laws and regulations.
- d. 20th April was the date of another "Monthly Awards Ceremony" at our school, during which numerous awards and certificates were presented for external academic, sports, and arts achievements. On that day, teachers and students together congratulated the award-winning students, and the teachers who have been nurturing their growth felt deeply gratified. We hope that students will continue to showcase their strengths, strive relentlessly, and pursue excellence.

### 3. Home-school cooperation:

- a. On 10th April, our school organized a briefing session for parents of Primary 5 and 6 students on the Secondary School Places Allocation (SSPA) system, introducing the mechanism, school selection methods, and important considerations to students and parents.
- b. On 14th April, our school's Parent-Teacher Association held a parent-child holistic learning experience activity at Sooper Yoo in Kennedy Town. Students and parents participated together in various indoor activities, including football games, an F1 mini racetrack, VR experiences, and a multi-level obstacle maze, with both parents and students thoroughly enjoying the event.
- c. On 28th April, our school hosted a lunch supplier briefing and tasting session, attended by 16 teachers, 22 parents, and 9 students. Parents provided feedback to the school on the suppliers' service quality, hygiene, pricing, and food taste.
