## School report, August

### 1. Teacher Professional Development

- a. After the votes of all the students and teachers, Ms. Leung Sze Nga and Mr. Zhong Hui were nominated as the teachers to be honored in the 28th Parents-Also-Appreciate-Teachers Drive. They will attend the prize presentation ceremony on 14th September, 2023.

### 2. Holistic Development of students

- a. We are pleased to announce that Cheng Nok and Yim Yuk Hau from 6A were awarded “Sportsboy & Sportsgirl of the Year 2022-2023” in All Hong Kong Primary Schools Prize Presentation Ceremony (Tsing Yi District) organized by the Schools Sports Federation of Hong Kong, China on 5th July. In addition to the prizes and certificates, Cheng Nok and Yim Yuk Hau were granted the scholarship offered by Hong Kong Elite Athletes Association. Their outstanding performance and effort were greatly appreciated.
- b. With the aim of cultivating students’ interests towards different musical instruments and types of music genres, the Symphonic Band from the Music Office was invited to perform an orchestra for Primary 1 to Primary 6 students on 10th July. A great number of famous Chinese and Western music pieces were performed using a vast variety of instruments, enabling students to learn more about the classification of Western Symphonic instruments (Woodwind and Brasswind) as well as the unique timbre produced by each instrument. Students thoroughly enjoyed the show and actively answered the questions raised by the performers.
- c. The “Appreciation Party for Teachers” was held on 10th July. Participating graduates, parents and teachers gathered to reminisce about the precious moments of graduates’ primary school life. Heart-felt performances were arranged and students kindly expressed their gratitude towards the teachers. There was a photo-taking session by the end of the party, marking the end of an unforgettable chapter in students’ life, a journey filled with countless memories.
- d. On 12th July, the Extraordinary Achievement Celebration Party was held to recognize students’ exceptional academic achievement and outstanding performances in various competitions. Over 130 students participated in the ceremony to share their honours and happiness. Parents were invited to take photos with the awardees on stage. The awardees and their parents were invited to share their thoughts on stage. After the ceremony, awardees, parents and teachers enjoyed some refreshments in a relaxing and welcoming environment at the tea party.
- e. From 24th July to 15th August, 41 summer courses were arranged, offering 510 spots to be enrolled at all levels. These courses mainly consisted Chinese Reading Comprehension Training, Cambridge English Course, Tutorial Class, Hip Hop, Jazz Dance, Oil Painting, Basketball, Football, LaCrosse, Rope Skipping for Fun, Gymnastics School Team. The Pre-Primary 1 students were able to take part in Djembe (African Drums), Jazz Dance, Drawing Cartoons, Soft Clay, Gymnastics and Playgroup with Native English Teacher.
- f. The Korea Study Tour, which was suspended for the past two years due to the pandemic, was held from 25th to 28th July. Students visited some of the most iconic attractions in Seoul Korea and embraced the latest technology and culture of Korea. Students visited the Hyundai Motor Studio Seoul, the Seoul Energy Dream Center, DMC Digital Media City Gallery (Seoul), BuCheon Robo Park, etc. This in turned deepened students’ understanding towards the advanced technology, culinary culture of Korea.
- g. From 28th August to 30th August, the P1 Adaptation Programme was held. Students were able to learn more about the core subjects such as Chinese, Mathematics and English and the corresponding subject teachers. Following the instructions given by the teachers, students would be able to adapt to their primary school life as soon as possible.
