School report, October

1. Teachers' Professional Development

- a. From 20th to 23rd October, our school principal was invited to join the Hong Kong STEM Education Alliance Delegation specially arranged for directors and principals in Shanghai, including a tour to the Science and Technology Innovation Source Functional Zone "Big Zero", the State Key Laboratory of Ocean Engineering, the Student Innovation Centre, the Shanghai Municipal Education Commission, meeting the principal of Shanghai Jiao Tong University and the Education Institute, etc.
- b. On 26th October, Mr. Ng, the Mathematics Consultant of our school and former School Development Officer of the Education Bureau's Primary School-based Curriculum Development Section, visited our school to launch this year's "School-based Mathematics Textbook Development Project". He held meetings and prepared lessons with Primary 6 mathematics teachers and provided many valuable suggestions for their teaching.

2. Holistic Development of students

- a. In order to establish students' positive values and let them understand the meaning of social inclusion, our school has arranged a movie appreciation activity, allowing students and parents to appreciate a movie "Distinction" starring Jo Kuk, Jennifer Yu and Kaki Sham. Students were invited to share their favourite moments and characters from the movie in the post-screening sharing session.
- b. The Music Department held a "Call in Your Request" activity during lunch time from October 16th to 30th. The aforementioned song requesting activity enables students to share and express their love through songs, fostering a sense of connection and appreciation for their families, teachers and fellow schoolmates, highlighting the importance of sharing love and care through music.
- c. The English Department organized a series of Halloween activities from 26th October to 31st October for students to learn about Western festivals and cultures, learn different English vocabulary and communicate in English. On 31st October, students dressed in various festive costumes and participated in activities to show their interest in learning English and improve their listening and speaking skills.

3. Home-School Cooperation

- a. On 3rd October, the election of the Parent Manager and Alternate Parent Manager of the Incorporated Management Committee was conducted. The counting of votes took place in the afternoon. Parents were invited to witness the counting of votes. Mr. Siu Yu Hing, parent of Siu Ching Ching from 3A and Siu Ching Yin from 5A was nominated for registration as the Parent Manager and Ms. Mak Sui Yu, parent of Kong Fuk Yin from 1B and Kong Yik Hei from 5B was nominated for registration as the Alternate Parent Manager, with a tenure of two years beginning from the day one is registered as a Parent Manager and Alternative Parent Manager.

b. On 15th October, our school participated in the activity “Caring ‘Inclusion’ Joy Charity Walk 2023” which was organized by Hong Kong Federation of Handicapped Youth.
