Circular on “Mainland Exchange Programme”

In order to enhance students' understanding of Chinese culture, our school has joined the “Mainland Exchange Programme for Junior Secondary and Upper Primary Students (History and Culture Series)” organized by The Education Bureau. Through this Programme, students can enhance their understanding of the history, culture, custom of the Mainland, thereby enhancing their sense of national identity. The details of the activity are as follows:

Venue	Foshan and Guangzhou
Assembly Time	2 nd February (Friday) , around 07:45
Dismissal Time	3 rd February (Saturday) , around 18:00
Assembly & Dismissal Point	Activity Room at school
Quota	About 30 participants
Target	P.4 to P.6 students of our school.
Activity summary	Take the high-speed train to Foshan or Guangzhou; visit the Guangzhou Cantonese Opera Activity Center to learn about the history, cultural and development of Cantonese opera; visit Nanfeng Ancient Stove, Guangdong Shiwan Ceramics Museum, Shiwan Doll Street and Foshan Ancestral Temple to appreciate the traditions of Lingnan Art and culture, such as ancient calligraphy and painting, ancient ceramics, Duan inkstone, Chaozhou or wood carving to enhance students' understanding of Chinese culture.
Fee	The fee is HK\$264 after subsidized by The Education Bureau. (Expenses include visit activities, meals, accommodation, transportation, and basic group comprehensive travel insurance.)
Travel documents	1. Hong Kong Identity Document, Mainland Travel Permit for Hong Kong and Macau Residents, or other valid travel documents. 2. Please submit the Health Declaration Form for Inbound and Outbound Travelers before crossing the border.
Remarks	1. Parents please complete the reply slip on or before 22 nd November 2023 (Wednesday) and return it to the teacher. No payment is needed at this stage. If the number of participants exceeds the quota, the list will be decided by drawing lots. Payment will be arranged after the announcement of the list of participants. 2. Students with high attendance at past school events will have a higher chance of being selected for the event.
