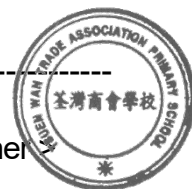

School report of November

1. Teachers' professional development

- a. On 3rd November, the Principal, the Vice-Principal, Mr Cheng Chung Hang, Mr Lee Sheung Lok, Ms Wong Chuk Kwan, Ms Lam Wai Yan and Mr Yiu Wai Lun took part in the CHATGPT workshop organized by the Association of Heads of Primary School Tsing Yi District, understanding the usage of the AI-tools in the field of teaching and administration.
- b. On 26th November, Mr Cheung Kwan To and Mr Liu Chun Yat attended the "Physical Education Teacher Award Presentation Ceremony." We would like to express our gratitude towards the dedication of the sports department.

2. Students' all-round development

- a. After routine training, our students tried their best to achieve good results in competitions. The students made great achievements in this year's inter-school track and field competition and got an outstanding result -- four gold medals, four silver medals, five bronze medals and nine third-runner-up medals.
- b. On 8th November, we held the Junior Police Call seminar. Students gained a new understanding of the system and various activities conducted by the Junior Police Call through the seminar, video-watching, games and the Q&A session.
- c. From 6th to 17th November, the school held a series of activities on understanding Chinese historical figures, including a short video on understanding Chinese dynasties and understanding Chinese historical figures. - d.
