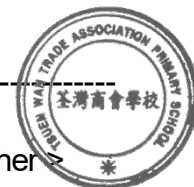

School report, December

1. Teachers' professional development

- a. On 8th December, Principal Chow, Ms Leung Sze-nga, Ms. Kwok Hoi-yan and Ms Chan Ka-yi attended the Seminar on Student Mental Health Concern: Early Identification and Support for Students with Mental Health Needs.
- b. On 19th December, our English consultant, Dr. Tang Mei Sin, conducted the lesson observation and the 8th school-based co-planning meeting which is scheduled to be held every two weeks with the English teachers to develop the school-based materials and promote the teaching strategies.

2. Students' all-round development

- a. From 27th November to 8th December, our school took part in an activity from Greening for the Chest "Cleaning for Charity." We conducted a cleaning your class competition to help students foster caring and develop good habits. Students were highly encouraged to clean at home. Parents were invited to record students' cleaning performance at home. Donations were made for reinforcement. They would be transferred to The Community Chest. Students who collect the most in donations would be awarded a certificate and the character strengths credit in caring, empathy and specification in the Outstanding Student Award Scheme 2023. The event raised a total of HKD \$3406 for The Community Chest.
- b. The school held a birthday party in November and December for students whose birthdays fall from September to December. Students celebrated their birthdays with their teachers and classmates. They also expressed their gratitude towards their teachers' and parents' for their love and care.
- c. On 2nd December, our school joined "Walk In" Charity Walk held by Fu Hong Society. Many parents joined the charity walk with their children.
- d. On 13th December, teachers and students of our school participated in the "Remember History and Cherish Peace - Student Memorial Activity and Student Works Exhibition on the 86th Anniversary of the Nanjing Massacre". This activity increases students' understanding of the Nanjing Massacre and cultivates a strong sense of belonging to the country and national identity. It allows them to reflect on and cherish today's hard-won peace. On the day of the event, students shared the cherished peace message of "Works for Survivors of the Nanjing Massacre" with the Secretary for Education, Dr. Choi Yuk Lin, principals and distinguished guests.
- e. On 14th December, our school joined the activity organised by the Digital Literacy Academy, the Hong Kong Association of Banks and the Hong Kong Federation of Youth Groups. The activity aimed at nurturing students with digital and anti-fraud knowledge, as well as building sound financial literacy to enable them to become savvy consumers and responsible digital citizens.
- f. From 18th to 21st December, the English Department organized various Christmas celebration activities. Students learned to sing Christmas songs and to make crafts and snacks. They also learnt more about Christmas vocabulary and, most importantly, that they had to share their love with others.
- g. Our school holds a Christmas party every year and arranges students to perform in a talent show. Many students signed up to participate in performances such as, singing, dancing and playing the musical instruments. Unique performances will be selected and arranged at the Christmas party by the Activity Department on 22nd December.
- h. On 23rd December, our students performed and held a game booth in the Christmas Carnival organised by Incorporated Owners Of Tsing Yi Estate.

3. Parent-school cooperation

- a. The Parent-Teacher Association held its first meeting of the year on 2nd December, reporting on the election of parent managers and substitute parent managers of the incorporated school management committee and the renewal arrangements for executive committee positions. The arrangements of the school year conference and events were discussed.
- b. The school planned a 2-hour preparatory course for Primary 1 students in December for three consecutive weekends. The course included a course on understanding and controlling emotions through games, learning gifted elements and English games. The children studied together, sang songs and played games, and they quickly adapted to their new learning environment. They were engaged, and spent meaningful time learning with laughter.
- c. On 7th December, a parent seminar for P.5 and P.6 students and their parents was held to let parents know about the mechanism for secondary schools' allocation. On the same day, the Assistant Principal of Wai Kiu College was invited to introduce secondary school life to the students and their parents.
- d. On 9th December, students and parents participated in the "Christmas Carnival" organized by Kam Kwong Yuen Long Integrated Community Service Center. Through a variety of performances, Christmas picture book story-telling session and creative handicrafts. Students and parents enjoyed it very much. It helps to raise the awareness of the mental health of children.
- e. On 21st December, the Parent-Teacher Association held an exploration trip to Hong Kong Disneyland. Students and parents took a tour of the seven parks to explore stories about Science, creativity, history and culture. Everyone was particularly excited to play in the newly opened Frozen theme park area and had an enjoyable time in the fairy tale world. This activity not only allowed children and parents to spend some quality time together but also created some unforgettable memories to the children.
