## School report, January

### 1. Teachers' professional development

- a. On 17th January, educational psychologist Ms. Choi Man Nga was invited to host a seminar titled "Supporting Students with Behavioral Differences" for all teachers, allowing teachers to discuss the factors that influence students' behavior and learn more about the stages of how disruptive behavior occurs.
- b. On 19th January, our school invited Professor Mak Yiu Kwong, a guest lecturer from the university to conduct a professional development activity with the school managers and teachers on the theme of "Positive Campus Participation" which focused on improving staff effectiveness and making good use of the resources to promote the development of positive education.

### 2. Students' all-round development

- a. In order to cultivate students' team spirit and give full play to their leadership skills, a 3-day education camp was arranged for Primary 5 students to visit Cheung Chau from 15th to 16<sup>th</sup> January. Through activities such as the Cheung Chau Community Search, Sai Wan Cheung Po Tsai Cave Exploration, Astronomy Exploration, Sand Castle Competition, BBQ Party, Environmental Project Study, and competitive games, students learnt how to get along with others and develop self-care and self-reliance abilities.
- b. A reunion event for the big brothers, big sisters, and junior students in Primary 1 was arranged on 17th January. Under the care of the senior brothers and sisters, students learnt to cherish the value of friendship. It also helped to cultivate students' sense of belonging to school.
- c. Students exerted team spirit and hard work in the competition and tried their best to strive for good results. The basketball team members successfully defended their title in the annual inter-school basketball competition on 19th January. Students have won the championship in both the men's and women's categories for two consecutive years. The team members will represent Tsing Yi District in the Hong Kong Inter-District Basketball Competition among primary schools.
- d. The visual art work of our students has been widely appreciated in the district. From November 2003 to April 2004, the visual art work display of students from our school and Chung Loi Kindergarten, an affiliated school of the Association, is scheduled to be held in more than ten different locations in Tsing Yi for a roving exhibition to showcase the school's achievements in art education to the public. In addition to allowing the community to appreciate students' visual art work, students' achievements in visual arts were widely acknowledged, recognizing their effort and building their self-confidence.

### 3. Home-school cooperation:

- a. To celebrate the 100 days of classes for Primary 1 students, our school held a "100 Days Banquet" at the Panda Hotel on the evening of 19th January. That night, the school invited many kindergarten principals and teachers from inside and outside the district to attend the 100 Days Banquet and witness the growth of the children. In their finest attire, Primary 1 students stepped onto the stage with confidence. In addition to thanking their parents and teachers for their guidance, students also presented flowers to their kindergarten teachers, showing their respect for them. Parents and teachers also discussed the students' learning progress during the event.
- b. On 29th January, the school held a charity annual flower sale organized by the Youth League. Many students and parents supported the event. Potted plants were bought and donations were made to the charity. The event raised a total of \$6,950 Hong Kong Dollars.
