School report, February

1. Teachers' professional development

- a. On 21st February, Dr. Chan Kong Neal, Senior Curriculum Development Officer of the Education Bureau's Primary School-based Curriculum Development Section, visited our school to hold a meeting and prepare lessons with Primary 4 Mathematics teachers and provided many valuable suggestions for their teaching.
- b. On 27th February, Dr. Tang Mei Sin, the consultant of the English Department held the 11th co-planning meeting with the English teachers, providing valuable advice to the teachers of the English Department.

2. Students' all-round development

- a. From 30th January to 5th February, we conducted training sessions and mock interviews for P.6 students to prepare them for secondary school interviews.
- b. The school's participation in the "Lunar New Year Celebration" on 2nd February, organized by Yan Chai Hospital Zonta Club of Kowloon Kindergarten/Child Care Centre showcased the students' dedication to service-learning and community engagement. The interactive booths hosted by Zhang Xi Yue, Huang Tsz Ham and Lau Kingsley including the popular "Reaction Light" game, not only brought joy to kindergarten students and community residents but also demonstrated the students' communication, expression and organizational skills.
- c. From 2nd February to 3rd February, in order to enhance students' understanding of the Chinese culture, our school joined the "Mainland Exchange Programme" which was organized by The Education Bureau. The visit to Guangzhou and Foshan allowed students to explore the history, culture and customs of the region, appreciate traditional arts and culture of Lingnan, and visit attractions such as the Guangzhou Cantonese Opera Activity Centre, Nanfeng Kiln, Guangdong Shiwan Ceramics Museum, Foshan Ancestral Temple. The hands-on experience enriched students' learning and cultural awareness.
- d. In order to enhance students' knowledge of Chinese traditional culture and enable students to feel the festive atmosphere, the school organized a number of Lantern Festival activities from 21st to 23rd February. By actively involving various traditional activities, such as lantern riddles, Chinese paper-cutting, soup tasting, thematic display panels and game booths, it created a lively and engaging environment that fostered a sense of community and unity among students. On 23rd February, many students dressed up and returned to school wearing traditional Chinese costumes to take photos with their teachers and classmates. The Lantern Festival activities were a great success and left a lasting impression on both students and teachers.
- e. On 28th February, the school held the Extraordinary Achievement Celebration Party (I) to recognize students who have demonstrated outstanding performance in external competitions and individual achievements. More than 150 parents attended the event, which included a group photo-taking session with the awardees on stage, as well as a performance appreciation session and a sharing session with the awardees, parents and teachers. After the ceremony, the awardees, parents and teachers participated in a celebratory tea party for a pleasant afternoon.

3. Home-school cooperation

- a. On 2nd February, our Speech Therapist, Ms Cheung, held a parents' talk on "Speech Training Elements in Daily Life" in the school hall. The talk provided insights into the four major speech aspects, the skills required for effective communication and practical tips on incorporating speech therapy elements into daily interactions with students. Parents who attended the talk shared positive feedback, noting that it raised their awareness of the importance of word choice, expression and speaking speed. They also appreciated learning about the design of activities and online resources that could support learning training at home. The talk highlighted the significance of integrating language training into daily life to enhance communication and relationships between parents and children. It was a beneficial opportunity for parents to gain

knowledge and skills that can positively impact their children's development and overall well-being.

- b. From 23rd to 25th February, our school joined the Year of Dragon Tsuen Wan Lantern Festival Bazaar. A stall was operated by parents and teachers at Tsuen Wan Sha Tsui Road Playground, selling special knick-knacks, keychains, hair accessories, etc.
