## School report, March

1. Teachers' professional development
  - a. On 11th March, the Principal, Ms. Leung Sze Nga and Ms. Chan Ka Yee attended a seminar to gain a better understanding of the "Mandatory Reporting of Child Abuse Bill".
  - b. On 21st March, the Principal, Vice Principal, Mr. Wong Wai Kit and Mr. Cheng Chung Hang participated in a workshop which aimed at enhancing the School Development and Accountability Framework.
2. Students' all-round development
  - a. On 29th February, the school hosted a seminar titled "What Do You Know About Indoor Air Quality" for students. Representatives from the Environmental Protection Department (EPD) provided insight on the importance of IAQ, common IAPs, sources of IAPs and how to improve IAQ. Students had the opportunity to view an indoor air quality model during recess and the instructor shared knowledge on maintaining environmental hygiene.
  - b. On 1st March, the school took part in the "Innovative Engineering Education Programme for Primary and Secondary Schools" co-organised by the Education Bureau and the Hong Kong Institution of Engineers. Students explored various fields of engineering, including mechanical, electrical engineering, civil engineering and aeronautical engineering. It enabled students to gain a deeper understanding of the innovative nature of the engineering community. The engineer shared her career journey and inspired students to pursue their engineering aspirations.
  - c. On 3rd March, the Dragon Dance Team and the Martial Arts Gymnastics Team of our school participated in the "Chinese New Year Carnival for the Elderly" organised by the Owners' Corporation of Clague Garden Estate at the podium of Clague Garden Estate in the afternoon. The students' performances were well-received by guests and residents, showcasing their talent and dedication.
  - d. The Chinese White Dolphin is one of the mascots of Hong Kong. To educate students on the Chinese White Dolphin (CWD) and promote conservation efforts, the school displayed an exhibit borrowed from the Agriculture, Fisheries, and Conservation Department from 4th to 15th March. Students engaged in quizzes and explored the exhibition to learn more about CWDs, their habitats, distribution, and conservation.
  - e. Judo, a martial art rooted in Jiu-Jitsu and recognized as an Olympic sport, was introduced to students through a training course on 6th March. Judo coaches and contestants provided an overview and demonstration, allowing students to experience the essence of judo and its appeal.
  - f. Yoga instructors led students in a yoga session on 13th March, incorporating breathing exercises, basic yoga movements, and singing bowl meditation. Students actively participated in the session, experiencing the physical and mental benefits of yoga practice.
  - g. On 14th March, represented as 3.14, which closely approximates the mathematical constant  $\pi$  (pi), many refer to this day as Pi Day. From 13th to 15th March, Mathematics teachers and Mathematics Ambassadors organized engaging activities centered around circles in the indoor playground for students of all levels during break and lunchtime to explore the concepts of circles and pi.
3. Home-school cooperation
  - a. On 23rd February, our school hosted a workshop on Parent-Child Relationship Enhancement which aimed to empower parents with skills to strengthen positive parenting skills and cultivate a good parent-child relationship through theoretical insights and case sharing. Parents learnt strategies to nurture strong connections with their children and address emotional or behavioral challenges with a positive mindset.
  - b. The second IMC meeting of the year was held on 27th February, providing guidance to school supervisors, SSB managers, and parent managers on school policies and initiatives. The meeting aimed to offer direction for the school's operational and developmental aspects.
  - c. On 12th March, two parent school managers and all teachers attended the Chinese New Year Members' Gala organized by the Tsuen Wan Trade Association. They enjoyed a dinner with school supervisors and managers, enhancing relationships and building stronger connections within the school community.
