School report, May

1. Teachers' professional development

- a. On 17th May, the Gifted Education Section of the Education Bureau visited the school to gain insights into the implementation of gifted education within the school. Discussions were held with the Curriculum Officer and Academic Officer regarding effective teaching strategies to promote gifted education.
- b. Ms. Leung Sze Nga and Ms. Kwok Mai Ze participated in the Visual Arts and STEAM Education Learning Community this year. They conducted approximately 10 exchange activities with teachers from other schools throughout the year to share teaching experiences, enhance professional abilities, improve learning and teaching effectiveness, and support schools in integrating arts and technology into education.

2. Students' all-round development

- a. Swimming is highlighted as one of the eight major learning areas in the PE program, beginning in May. Every student is provided with the opportunity to develop swimming skills. The school incorporates swimming lessons into the Physical Education curriculum for Primary 3 and Primary 4 students each year to cultivate their enthusiasm for swimming.
- b. To boost students' sports knowledge and interest, Primary 1 students participated in a motor skills training workshop organized by Cheers Up Charity Foundation on 7th May. The workshop aimed to promote healthy living, and the students showed great enthusiasm and energy.
- c. Primary 6 students embarked on a two-day and one-night study tour focused on "Archaeology, Cheung Chau" from 10th to 11th May. The tour included simulated archaeological excavation experiences, outdoor cultural tours, and a 'Lucky Buns' workshop to explore the history and cultural stories of Cheung Chau, preserving and appreciating local history and culture.
- d. A Mother's Day-themed interdisciplinary thanksgiving activity was organized in early May to nurture students' moral character. Activities such as Chinese and English card writing, Mathematics heart box making, music singing, and badge making by the counseling team were conducted. Through these activities, students learn to value family bonds and express gratitude through words and actions in their daily lives.
- e. The General Studies subject organizes field trips for all levels to complement classroom teaching and allow students to expand their horizons. Primary 1 students visited Tsing Yi Park on 3rd and 13th May to learn about the flowers and facilities in the park. This outdoor learning experience aims to spark students' interest in learning beyond the confines of the classroom.
- f. On 21st May, Kwai Tsing District conducted an "Anti-Deception Oath Ceremony" at our school to instill early anti-deception awareness in students through simple and solemn activities. Kwai Tsing District Commander Chief Superintendent Au Yeung Mun-yee, Principal Chow, "Kwai Xun Crime Prevention Pioneer" Grape, and District Councillor Pang Yap-ming led teachers, students, and Community Care Team members in taking the oath. Kwai Xun Crime Prevention Pioneer Chung Janine introduced the students to the "Anti-Scam App" and its operation.

3. Home-school cooperation

- a. Our school held the 2024-2025 school lunch tasting session on 29th April and invited our parents and students be the representatives in the tasting session for assessment. On 9 May, committee members of the Parent-Teacher Association also gave advice to the school on the selection of lunch suppliers for the new school year.
- b. The "Children's Football Competition" was held at our school on 11th May, with many parents bringing their children to participate. The school aims to cultivate students' interest in sports from a young age, emphasizing the benefits of regular exercise for physical fitness, self-confidence, and mental health. Parents appreciated the event and its positive impact on their children.

c. On 18th May, PTA organized a parent-child trip to Yuen Long Organic Low Carbon Ecological Park Yuen Long Pineapple Garden, followed by a visit to the Ping Shan Heritage Trail. Participants will enjoy the hotel buffet and explore unique historical sites along the trail, taking advantage of the good weather for a memorable experience.
