#### School report, June

1. Teachers' professional development

On 21st June, the Inspector from the Education Bureau's Student Support Team conducted a year-end visit to our school. During the visit, the Inspector received a comprehensive briefing on the school's initiatives in various areas from the Student Support Officer Kwok Hoi Yan, and provided valuable feedback on our programs.

- 2. Students' all-round development
  - a. In mid-June, the school organized an interdisciplinary gratitude activity centered around Father's Day. The counselling team collaborated with the Chinese, English, and Mathematics departments to facilitate activities where students expressed heartfelt wishes to their fathers through reading English books, listening to father-themed songs, creating hand-painted fans, crafting wish cards, and making wish boxes. These activities aimed to teach students the significance of honoring and being filial to their parents.
  - b. To encourage students to delve into history and culture and foster patriotism, the school hosted the event "Light and Shadow on Campus" on 18th June. Students and teachers watched the movie "Chang An" together. This film narrates the tales of Gao Shi, Li Bai, Du Fu, and others post the An Lu Shan Rebellion, evoking a range of emotions among the viewers. Following the screening, students penned down their reflections on the movie, using writing to express their sentiments and reactions towards the Chinese national spirit portrayed in "Chang An".
  - c. On 22nd June, a group of 18 students visited the airport to take part in the MTR Budding stationmaster activity. They diligently addressed passengers' queries and actively supported the station's daily operations. The MTR staff commended the students for their exceptional performance and dedication to their responsibilities.
  - d. On 23rd June, students from Primary 1 to 3 embarked on an enriching summer adventure course at Ocean Park. They had the opportunity to closely observe and interact with sea lions or seals, learning about their physical attributes and engaging in various challenging tasks. These activities facilitated a deeper understanding of animals, marine ecology, conservation efforts, and the importance of ocean protection and reducing greenhouse gas emissions, providing a rare and valuable learning experience.
  - e. A Putonghua-themed study day was held on 25th June. The event featured several booth games designed to help students practise and apply their oral skills acquired through daily learning. The students actively participated in the games, showcasing their engagement and enjoyment in the learning process.
  - f. The school organized another "Monthly Awards Ceremony" on 25th June, where external academic, STEM, and sports awards and certificates were presented to deserving recipients. Teachers and students came together to congratulate the awardees, bringing a sense of pride to the educators who have nurtured their students' growth. It is hoped that students will continue to showcase their talents, work diligently, and strive for excellence.
  - g. On 26th June, our school invited the Chatteris Educational Foundation to organize an English drama event targeting students from Primary 3 to 5. Native-speaking English tutors and over twenty volunteers led the students through the drama sessions to ensure their full engagement. The students had a great time participating in various English drama activities and relished the experience of learning English. The English tutors encouraged the students to unleash their creativity and perform the storyline spontaneously. The students demonstrated their confidence and delivered impressive performances.
  - h. To foster students' teamwork and leadership skills, Primary 6 students participated in a 3-day, 2-night graduation camp in Mui Wo. Activities such as Mui Wo orientation, adventure tasks, sandcastle competitions, cannon building, and competitive games were arranged. These activities aimed to enhance students' interpersonal skills, strengthen relationships with classmates and teachers before graduation, and engage in farewell activities.

### 3. Home-school cooperation

- a. To educate students on the traditions and significance of the Dragon Boat Festival while strengthening parent-child bonds, our school partnered with the Tsuen Wan Trade Association Chung Loi Kindergarten on 1st June. The collaborative effort resulted in a Dragon Boat Festival Parent-Child Fun Day featuring various activities such as a rice dumpling making workshop and dragon boat racing games. Students worked together to create intricate Dragon Boat Festival stickers, which were then placed on the rice dumplings made during the workshop. These rice dumplings, along with heartfelt blessings for good health, were distributed to nearby Tsing Yi residents during the festival. The event provided a unique experience for parents and students, fostering a delightful morning together.
- b. On 21st June, the Chinese Dance Team of our school participated in the performance of " Dear Mom and Dad Cultural Performance," at Tsuen Wan Town Hall to celebrate the 27th anniversary of Hong Kong's return to the motherland. The students showed their dancing postures with full attention, and the warm applause and appreciation from the audience made the students feel happy and satisfied. The invaluable support of parent volunteers in this dance performance cannot be overstated. They took on the role of makeup artists backstage, meticulously preparing and beautifying the students. In addition to assisting with dressing and accessorizing, they provided unwavering encouragement and support to the students. We extend our sincere gratitude to these parent volunteers for their commitment and contributions, as they have truly impacted every moment of the show.
