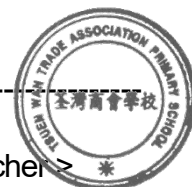

## School report, July & August

### 1. Teacher Professional Development

- a. After the votes of all the students and teachers, Ms. Leung Sze Nga and Mr. Yiu Wai Lun were nominated as the teachers to be honored in the 29th Parents-Also-Appreciate-Teachers Drive. They will attend the prize presentation ceremony on 10th September, 2024.

### 2. Holistic Development of students

- a. On 8th July, the school held an "Appreciation Party for Teachers". On the day of the event, in addition to all the teachers and graduating students in attendance, dozens of parents also participated. Teachers, students, and parents reminisced about the fun events from their six years of studying together through old photos. The graduating students expressed their gratitude to the teachers in different ways, including singing and performing. The graduating students took photos with the teachers, exuding a bittersweet and joyful atmosphere.
- b. On July 12th, the school held the Extraordinary Achievement Celebration Party (II) to recognize students with outstanding performance and remarkable achievements in external competitions and individual accomplishments. Over 160 parents attended the event. During the ceremony, in addition to parents taking photos on stage with their award-winning children, there were also performance programs, as well as sharing sessions by the award-winning students, parents, and teachers. After the ceremony, the award-winning students, parents, and teachers participated in a celebratory tea party, enjoying a pleasant mid-day together.
- c. From July 13th to 16th, our students participated in the 'Guangzhou-Hong Kong-Macao Youth Science and Technology of Sports Model Summer Camp and Sea, Land, and Air Model Triathlon Invitational Competition' held in Guangzhou. During this event, our students played friendly water-based soccer and soccer matches with teams from Guangzhou and Macau. Our students performed excellently, not only immersing themselves and enjoying the competitions, but also achieving third place. During the event, the students also visited the Guang Zhou Ai Fei Le Feng Dong flight base to personally experience the joy of flying. The itinerary also included visits to the GAC New Energy Automotive Industrial Park, the National South China Sea Marine Bureau, the South China Sea Ecological Centre, the Guangdong-Hong Kong-Macao Greater Bay Area Marine Disaster Early Warning Centre, and the Guangdong Institute of Artificial Intelligence and Advanced Computing.
- d. The school was invited to participate in the Beijing Jinchang Aerospace Training Camp organized by the Hong Kong Aerospace Society from July 18th to 23rd. After a selection process, three students, Xu Yiming from 5B, Colmer William from 6A, and Cheung Ho Kwan from 6D, were given the opportunity to participate for free. They set foot on the Mars Base 1, experienced simulated Martian life, and participated in the Zhu Rong Mars expedition, learning to design and operate Mars rovers. The students later visited the China Space Museum in Beijing to understand the development of China's space program, and also went to the Qian Xuesen Youth Aerospace Science Institute to participate in simulated launch control exercises and experience astronaut training facilities. At the closing ceremony of the training camp, they gathered together for a "Mars Night Chat" to share their gains and experiences from the journey.
- e. Germany & Switzerland STEAM study tour to lead students to Germany and Switzerland to learn about technology and western culture. Students visited the Germany Museum of Science and Technology in Berlin, the site of the wall, Checkpoint Charlie, the Brandenburg Gate, the Reichstag, the Kremer Bridge in Erfurt, the Speyer Museum of Technology in Frankfurt, Heidelberg Castle, the Porsche Museum in Stuttgart, the Deutsch's Museum in Munich, Marienplatz, the New Town Hall, Neuschwanstein Castle, Linderhof Palace, the Titlis Snow Mountain in Lucerne, Switzerland, Lake Lucerne, the Cabell Bridge, the Lion Monument, the Palais des Nations in Geneva, Lake Geneva, St. Peter's Basilica, In the rose garden, brown bear's den, Bern Cathedral and Federation Square in Bern. The students have experienced a lot in the tour.
- f. The school organized 30 summer courses from July 18th to August 9th. The summer courses mainly included Chinese Reading Comprehension Training, English Playgroup, Tutorial Classes, Hip Hop, painting, rope skipping, gymnastics team, lacrosse, and judo experience. Our Pre-Primary 1 students also had the opportunity to participate in some of the programs,

including Djembe (African Drums), Drawing Cartoons, Gymnastics, and Playgroup with Native English Teacher.

- g. From August 28th to 30th, P1 Adaptation Programme was held. Students get to interact with Chinese, English, and Math teachers. Understanding the requirements of each subject teacher, allowing the students to adapt to primary school life as soon as possible.

### 3. Home-school Cooperation

- a. The graduation ceremony was held on 7th July to mark the completion of school studies by the students. Mr. Chu Chung Shing, BBS MH, Chairman of Tsuen Wan Trade Association Education Foundation Ltd. presented the graduation certificates, and Supervisor and Board of Trustees presented the scholarship and prizes to students for their outstanding academic achievement and excellent conduct. Graduates, the awardees and their parents took part in the ceremony, witnessing the unforgettable moment with the awardees. The student performance segment includes the school's gymnastics team, rope skipping team, and Chinese dance troupe. The students and parents attending the ceremony are very enthusiastic, and the entire event is filled with joy.
- b. On 19th July, the "PTA Day Camp" was held in Wu Kwai Sha Youth Village. Parents and students actively participated in it, especially the "Group Badminton Activity." The school's badminton shuttlecock feeder sparked the interest of the students. They actively engaged in a variety of activities such as Table Tennis, Recreation Chess, Football Machine and Floor Curling. The students and parents are very engaged and cherish the moments of parent-child activities and sports. They greatly value these opportunities to bond and participate together.
- c. On August 28th, the school holds a new student orientation day for parents of Primary 1 students and transfer students. This allows parents to become familiar with the school's daily routines, and understand their children's learning, activities, lunch, and rest schedules at school, in order to prepare and coordinate accordingly.
