School report, October

1. Teachers' Professional Development

- a. From 23rd to 28th October, the principal participated in a professional exchange tour to celebrate the 75th anniversary of the founding of the People's Republic of China. In addition to visiting Beijing, the tour included a visit to Shenyang City in Liaoning Province. This National Day visit aimed to enhance educators' understanding of the country's history, culture, and latest developments, as well as to promote cooperation among educators from both regions. During the trip, the delegates visited the Liaoning Provincial Experimental School, the "September 18" Historical Museum, the Shenyang Imperial Palace Museum, schools in Beijing, Museum of the Communist Party of China, and the Shijingshan District Planning Exhibition Centre, among other sites.
- b. Mr Wong Chi Wai participated in the "Mainland Study Tours for Newly-Joined Teachers (2024/25) - Guangzhou (1)" organized by the Education Bureau. He went to Guangzhou for a four-day study tour starting on 25th September. The itinerary focused on exploring the development of the Greater Bay Area, understanding innovative teaching and technology applications, visiting key schools, attending specialized lectures, and touring high-tech enterprises. The aim was to enhance teaching quality and promote professional development for teachers.
- c. On 14th to 18th October, Ms Kwok Hoi Yan attended the Professional Development Programme for the SENCOs in Ordinary Primary and Secondary Schools (block 1), held by the Research and Development Centre for Integrated and Special Education of the Faculty of Education of the University of Hong Kong. This programme is to understand the latest development of inclusive education and how to implement the "whole-school approach" model of inclusive education.

2. Holistic Development of students

- a. The school participated in the "Inno4life Creative Culture and Technology Innovation Exhibition 2024" held at the Hong Kong Convention and Exhibition Centre from 4th to 6th October. At this event full of creativity and technology, our STEAM student ambassadors showcased various competition projects, including augmented reality designs, metaverse creations, and app development. They also shared engaging classroom learning experiences such as LegoWe2.0 programming and drone programming.
- b. To enhance students' understanding of Chinese culture, the school organized a four-day study tour to Beijing from 17th to 20th October. This trip aimed to deepen students' knowledge of mainland history, culture, and customs, and to strengthen national identity and patriotism. The group of 34 participants watched the flag-raising ceremony at Tiananmen Square, visited their sister school, Beijing Dacheng School, and toured Nanluoguxiang, Wangfujing Street, old hutongs, the Summer Palace, Yuanmingyuan, the Great Wall, the Forbidden City, and the Temple of Heaven. The students gained valuable insights and experiences.
- c. Our school's flag-raising team members, accompanied by teachers, traveled to Shenzhen from 19th to 20th October to participate in the "Hong Kong-Shenzhen Youth Celebration of the 75th Anniversary of the Founding of the People's Republic of China Flag-Raising Ceremony." This event was co-organized by the Hong Kong Flag-raising Association and the Shenzhen Futian District Education Bureau. In addition to attending the solemn flag-raising ceremony, students had the opportunity to engage in exchanges with mainland flag-raising teams. Following the ceremony, they visited the Pengcheng Youth Activity Camp in Shenzhen to participate in military experience activities, gaining valuable insights into military knowledge and experiencing the daily routines of soldiers.
- d. On 19th October, 17 students from our school visited the CMC Resuscitation Training Centre to acquire first aid skills. They learned basic techniques for handling injuries, such as stopping nosebleeds and bandaging wounds on limbs. Students practiced assisting injured individuals by treating wounds, followed by evaluations from the instructor. They also learned CPR, gaining a deeper understanding of how to save individuals experiencing cardiac and respiratory arrest.

- e. On 19th October, students engaged in service learning at the STEAM Day of Creative Kindergarten (Tsing Yi), providing interactive learning activities for the kindergarten students. These included using games designed with App Inventor to learn English and math, exploring the natural world through virtual reality glasses, discovering the world of dinosaurs with augmented reality books, and interacting with AI robots. The kindergarten students were highly enthusiastic.
- f. The English Department organized a series of Halloween activities from October 28 to 31. While learning about Western festivals and culture, students also expanded their English vocabulary and practiced communication skills. On 31st October, students dressed in various costumes and actively participated in the activities, enhancing their interest in learning English and improving their English listening and speaking skills.

3. Home-School Cooperation

- a. To enhance students' interest in reading and boost parents' confidence in storytelling, the school held a storytelling workshop for parents on 4th October. During the workshop, teachers shared tips with parents on how to choose suitable books for their children, guide them into the storyline, and use interactive questions to deepen their understanding of the story. The objective was to not only elevate parents' confidence in storytelling but also to enable them to enjoy the experience of sharing stories with their children.
- b. From 17th to 21st October, our Parent-Teacher Association participated in the "Celebrating the 75th Anniversary of the Founding of the People's Republic of China Floating Colours Carnival" at Sha Tsui Road Playground, Tsuen Wan. The event featured a booth selling eco-friendly bags designed and hand-drawn by students, who also participated in performances. With strong parental support, this activity provided students with valuable service-learning experiences.
