## School report of November

### 1. Teachers' professional development

- a. On 4th November, Ms. Leung Sze Nga and Mr. Ng Yiu Kei participated in the "Professional Conduct, Values and Education Policies" course organized by the Education Bureau. This deepened their understanding of the Constitution, the Basic Law, national security education, and educational policies, and facilitated leading their team in practicing professional ethics and values.
- b. On 22nd November, all teachers participated in the Professional Development Day organized by the Tsing Yi District Primary School Principals' Association. This event provided teachers with a deeper understanding of how to support and enhance students' mental health.

### 2. Students' all-round development

- a. The awards ceremony for the 4th "China's Aerospace Dream" 2024 Dongguan, Hong Kong, Macau, and Taiwan Overseas Chinese Essay Competition took place recently. Our students achieved remarkable success in this competition, winning three awards. On 6th November, the award-winning students and their parents attended the ceremony held at the Chong Yuet Ming Cultural Centre at the University of Hong Kong, sharing in the joy of their achievements. On the same day, our school also established a sister school relationship with a school in Dongguan. Principal Chow Kim Ho and Principal Bao Dongmei from Dongguan Chashan Central Primary School conducted a signing ceremony at the award ceremony, exchanging souvenirs to symbolize the formal establishment of their sister school relationship. The two schools plan to engage in various exchange activities in the future, creating more opportunities for interaction and learning for students from both Dongguan and Hong Kong.
- b. On 19th November, our P.6 students participated in a General Studies Field Trip to the Ho Koon Nature Education cum Astronomical Centre. They engaged in hands-on learning about the design cycle by designing, constructing, and testing various mechanisms.

### 3. Parent-school cooperation

- a. On 16th November, the school participated in the "Dream the Great Wall Handicraft Workshop" organized by the Tung Cheng Yuen Lam Tong Charitable Foundation Limited. This event allowed students and parents to learn about the Great Wall of China and fostered parent-child relationships. Additionally, the "2024 International Jigong Cultural Festival" featured booth games that enabled students and parents to explore Ji Gong culture and understand the expression of the traditional Chinese value of "benevolence."
- b. To provide students with beneficial outdoor learning activities and the joy of group living, our school held an outdoor learning Day on 21st November with the participation of parents. P.1 to P.3 students visited Lingnan Garden in Mei Foo and P.4 to P.6 students went to Tai Mo Shan Country Park. Group activities brought the students together, which is crucial for their social and emotional development. Additionally, stepping out of the classroom to learn how to interact with peers and adapt to a new environment are valuable experiences gained from the field trip. The students had a fulfilling and meaningful day.
- c. To strengthen the relationship between parents and children and to provide students with beneficial physical and mental learning activities, the school participated in the "Bouncy Soccer Cup" parent-child event organized by the Cheers Up Foundation Limited on 22nd November. This expansive 5,000-square-foot giant trampoline featured seven inflatable challenge zones that incorporated various elements of football. It provided children with the opportunity to release their energy while enhancing their physical coordination and reaction skills, thereby helping them discover their athletic potential.

- d. On Parent's Day, held on 29th November, class teachers engaged in discussions with parents regarding their children's learning progress. They communicated about the overall situation of the students since the beginning of the school year, including aspects such as behavioral habits, academic performance, and examination results.
