## School report, December

### 1. Teachers' professional development

- a. From 9th to 13th December, Ms. Kwok Hoi-yan attended the Professional Development Programme for the Special Educational Needs Coordinators in order to further enhance the effectiveness of the support given to students with SEN.
- b. On 10th December, Chinese teachers held a meeting on Chinese with the consultant from the Education Bureau to discuss and develop the teaching strategies and school-based materials to support non-Chinese speaking students in learning Chinese.

### 2. Students' all-round development

- a. The school held a birthday party in December for students whose birthdays fall from September to December. Students celebrated their birthdays with their teachers and classmates. This year, the "Happy Birthday Jukebox Station" was held during the Birthday Week, and the students were very enthusiastic to participate. They took this opportunity to thank their great parents for their dedication and gratitude to their classmates and friends for their love and help.
- b. In response to the "Mental Health Month 2024" with the theme of "Connecting with the People Around You" and to express concern and care for students' mental health, our school organized a variety of activities in December in accordance with the four elements of the "4Rs Mental Health Charter". Through the activities, students can learn about mental health in a relaxed and happy atmosphere. Students can also find empathy, feel each other's support and encouragement.
- c. From 16th to 19th December, the English Department organized various Christmas celebration activities. Students learned to sing Christmas songs and to make snacks. They also learnt more about Christmas vocabulary and, most importantly, that they had to share their love with others.
- d. Our school holds a Christmas party every year and arranges students to perform in a talent show. Many students signed up to participate in performances such as, singing, dancing and playing the musical instruments. Unique performances will be selected and arranged at the Christmas party by the Activity Department on 20th December.
- e. On 21st December, our students and teachers were invited to performed in the "Tsuen Wan District Youth Arts and Sports E-sports Carnival" at Sha Tsui Road Playground. Through the performance of teachers and students, we had fun with everyone and sent blessings to everyone in this festive season.
- f. Our school is constantly innovative. In terms of campus facilities, our new Aerospace Technology Learning Spot has been completed. At the beginning of the next term, all students will be studying aerospace courses at this location. The hardware and interesting programmes are ready for the students.

### 3. Parent-school cooperation

The school has planned a two-hour preparatory class for prospective Primary One students for three consecutive weekends in late November and December 1, which includes a growth lesson on learning to understand and control emotions through games, learning of gifted elements and English games. The children learned, sang and played together, and everyone quickly adapted to the new learning environment, engaged and had meaningful learning time with laughter.
