School report, January

1. Teachers' professional development

- a. On 10th January, Mr. Wong Chi Wai participated in a professional development course for primary school science teachers, where he learned about the primary school science curriculum content and mastered various teaching and assessment strategies.
- b. Mental health is of paramount importance for individuals, as it significantly influences their capacity to cope with normal life stresses, realize their potential, engage in effective learning and work, maintain positive interpersonal relationships, and contribute to society. In light of this, the school organized a mental health workshop for all teachers on 13th January. The objective of this workshop was to provide comprehensive information regarding mental health and mental illness, thereby cultivating accurate concepts, understanding, and attitudes towards seeking help and treatment.
- c. During the celebration event for the 75th anniversary of the founding of the People's Republic of China, jointly organized by the New Territories School Head Association and the Kowloon Region School Heads Association. Our school received the School Commendation Award. Additionally, Ms. Ko Ka Foon, Ms. Leung Sze Nga, Ms. Lam Wai Yan, Mr. Ho Hing Wing, and Mr. Tam Wai Wah were awarded the Teacher Commendation Award.

2. Students' all-round development

- a. To strengthen students' national consciousness and enhance their sense of national pride, our school participated in the "Hong Kong and National Situations Campus Promotion Activity" organized by the Hong Kong Youth Power Association on 13th January. Through this event, students gained insights into the content of China's modernization, which increased their understanding of national development and laid a solid foundation of knowledge about their country from an early age. Additionally, students enjoyed a face-changing performance, where the performer engaged in entertaining interactions with them, allowing students to experience Chinese traditional culture up close and fostering a greater sense of identity as citizens.
- b. To enrich students' post-examination campus life and reinforce their understanding of music, the music department organized a music-themed booth game activity on 13th January, in which all students participated. Through these engaging booth games, students reviewed essential musical concepts and skills, including notes, beats, rhythms, and instrument performance. In a relaxed and enjoyable atmosphere, students had the opportunity to appreciate music while simultaneously enhancing their knowledge, thereby integrating learning with enjoyment and improving their overall musical literacy.
- c. The school arranged for an environmental education game booth and a recycling booth in collaboration with the Environmental Protection Department on 14th January. Additionally, Green Link was invited to conduct a seminar on low-carbon living, as well as workshops on recycled paper and natural mosquito repellent bags. These activities aimed to raise students' awareness of the importance of low-carbon living and to enhance their understanding of natural products, environmental protection, and sustainable lifestyles.
- d. From 13th to 16th of January, the school organized a values education activity titled "Respect Others" for students in primary one to six, hosted by the English department. NET teachers employed engaging and entertaining stories to reinforce the concept of respecting others among the students. Students actively participated in the activities and completed related worksheets afterward, allowing them to consolidate their learning.
- e. To cultivate students' teamwork spirit and enhance their leadership skills, the school arranged for fifth-grade students to participate in a 3-day, 2-night educational camp on Cheung Chau from 15th to 17th January. Through activities such as a community treasure hunt, exploration of Cheung Po Tsai's Cave, astronomy exploration, sandcastle competitions, a barbecue evening, environmental themed studies, and competitive games, students learned interpersonal skills and developed their ability to be self-sufficient and independent.

3. Home-school cooperation:

- a. To celebrate the 100 days of classes for Primary 1 students, our school held a "100 Days Banquet" at the Panda Hotel on the evening of 10th January. That night, the school invited many kindergarten principals and teachers from inside and outside the district to attend the 100 Days Banquet and witness the growth of the children. In their finest attire, Primary 1 students stepped onto the stage with confidence. In addition to thanking their parents and teachers for their guidance, students also presented flowers to their kindergarten teachers, showing their respect for them. Parents and teachers also discussed the students' learning progress during the event.
- b. On 24th January, the school held a charity annual flower sale organized by the Youth League. Many students and parents supported the event. Potted plants were bought and donations were made to the charity. The event raised a total of \$4,150 Hong Kong Dollars.
- c. On 25th January, the Parent-Teacher Association held its second meeting of the year to discuss the activities that will be organized during the school year.
