School report, March

- 1. Teachers' professional development
 - a. On 11th March, Dr. Tang Mei Sin, the English subject consultant, visited the school to conduct the eleventh collaborative lesson planning and observation session of the year with the subject teachers, focusing on developing English teaching materials and discussing related teaching strategies.
 - b. On 13th March, Chinese subject teachers attended the "Reading Strategies for Children's Books" teacher workshop, where they collaboratively discussed learning strategies and teaching methods to support students' reading.

1. Students' all-round development

- a. The school participated in the "Inter-school Money Management Quiz Competition", organized by the Investor and Financial Education Council and supported by the Education Bureau. Out of 96 participating primary schools, 8 advanced to the finals. Our school's representative team stood out among the eight finalist teams in the final held on 1st March, ultimately winning the championship. After our school's students won the championship in the Inter-school Money Management Quiz Competition, they were invited by the Investor and Financial Education Council to become "Junior Financial Ambassadors." On 22nd March, the Junior Financial Ambassadors, together with their parents, visited the IFEC FinEd Hub, the Digital Investor and Financial Education Experiential Learning Centre, learning financial wisdom through interactive play.
- b. On 8th March, the Primary 6 "Understanding Adolescent Project" program participants went to the Sai Kung Outdoor Recreation Centre for a day camp activity. Through the activities, the participants learned to follow rules, develop personal thinking skills, enhance their focus and attitude, and improve harmonious interpersonal relationships.
- c. On 14th March, a day widely known as Pi Day, the Mathematics teachers and Math Ambassadors organized various circle-related mathematical fun activities with students of all levels during the morning recess and lunch break at the indoor playground, where they learned about circles and the concept of pi together.
- d. On 23rd March, the school arranged for members of the Hong Kong Road Safety Patrol to attend the Hong Kong Police College for the annual parade of the Hong Kong Road Safety Patrol. The members marched on the college's parade ground with neat and powerful steps, saluting the guest of honor, Professor Dong SUN, JP, Secretary for Innovation, Technology and Industry, who inspected the various teams. The members displayed confidence under the gaze of the Secretary, senior officers, and numerous commanders.
- e. On 25th March, our school collaborated with the Early Childhood Education Department of the Li Ka Shing School of Professional and Continuing Education at Hong Kong Metropolitan University to implement a Finnish education model featuring STEAM play-based teaching. The initiative explored the effectiveness of the Finnish education model on young primary school children. In the classroom, students engaged in self-directed learning and hands-on experiences, creating and imagining their own designs. The program invited parents to participate and introduced them to the concepts and benefits of this play-based teaching approach. Parents observed the instructors facilitating the activities and their children's involvement. The students showed great interest in the activities, and parents expressed a desire to join the next phase of the parent education program.

3. Home-school cooperation

- a. On 1st March, the Parent-Teacher Association held a family outing with a rich itinerary, including a visit to the Kam Tin Country Club, an all-you-can-eat barbecue, and tours of the Kam Tin Mural Village and Red Brick House, as well as visits to various traditional historical sites. Both parents and students had a thoroughly enjoyable time, strengthening parent-child bonds while also fostering connections between parents and teachers.
- b. On 6th March, the parent managers and the chairperson of the Parent-Teacher Association, along with all the teachers, attended the Tsuen Wan Trade Association Spring Festival Members' Gala, enjoying a dinner together with the school supervisor and school managers.
